

Ohio Resident Educator Program

Annual Resident Educator Program Requirements

The Ohio Resident Educator Program began in 2011 and has continued to incorporate best practices identified by local districts and schools. The Ohio Resident Educator Program is a comprehensive multi-year induction program, resulting in Professional Teaching Licensure. The mentoring program is established by the local district/school and provides teachers with support and guidance as they begin their teaching career.

The following requirements for resident educators provide a foundational basis for professional development in the Resident Educator Program.

Area of Focus	Resident Educator Requirements (2018-2019)
Self-Assessment	<i>Annually, complete the Ohio Teacher Evaluation (OTES) Self-Assessment.</i>
Goal-Setting	<i>Annually, complete the Ohio Teacher Evaluation System (OTES) professional growth plan.</i>
Program Year 1	<i>Complete Mentoring Year 1:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>The Teaching and Learning Cycle (Plan, Teach, Assess, Reflect, and Revise)</i> <i>Complete Focused Mentoring Year 1:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Communication</i><i>Collaboration</i><i>Professional Growth</i>
Program Year 2	<i>Complete Mentoring Year 2:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>The Teaching and Learning Cycle (Plan, Teach, Assess, Reflect, Revise)</i> <i>Complete Focused Mentoring Year 2:</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><i>Formative and Summative Assessment</i> <i>Optional: Complete the RESA following consultation with local program coordinator and mentor.</i>
Program Year 3	<i>Complete Resident Educator Summative Assessment (RESA)</i>
Program Year 4	<i>Engage in activities as determined by the district or school.</i> <i>Note: Completion of all 4 Program Years is required even if the RE passed the RESA in a previous year.</i>
