

## A Frog






A frog is an animal that spends part of its life in the water and part on land.

When frogs are first born, they are called tadpoles. Tadpoles hatch from eggs in water. Tadpoles are born with tails but not with legs.

When tadpoles begin to grow legs they get their back legs first and then their front legs.

Soon their tails get smaller and smaller until their tails are gone. When their tails are gone, they are frogs and are ready to live on land.





In the spring, frogs lay eggs in the water that will soon hatch and become tadpoles.

Grown-up frogs like to swim, but they also like to hop on land.

Frogs eat insects, worms and spiders that they find both in water and on land.
