

Ohio State of Ohio Testing Methodologies


OVERVIEW

State law requires the Ohio Department of Education to release information regarding the number of districts and schools that administered the required assessments in all of the following ways: (1) completely online; (2) completely on paper; and (3) in any combination of online and paper.

ASSESSMENT TYPES

BY STUDENT


During the 2014-2015 school year, 64% of Ohio students completed the required state assessments online and 36% of students completed assessments on paper.

BY DISTRICT


There are 608 school districts in the state of Ohio that participated in the 2014-2015 state assessments. 102 districts (17%) completed the assessments only online; 75 districts (12%) completed the assessments only on paper; 431 districts (71%) administered both paper and online assessments to students.

BY SCHOOL

There are 2,985 schools in the state of Ohio that participated in the 2014-2015 state assessments. 1,008 schools (34%) completed the assessments only online; 794 schools (27%) completed the assessments only on paper; 1,183 schools (40%) administered both paper and online assessments to students.

ASSESSMENT BY DISTRICT TYPOLOGY

TECHNOLOGY CAPACITY

432

Based on 2013 survey data, 432 of Ohio's public school districts were capable of providing 100% of assessments online. 12 districts reported as unable to provide 100% of assessments online. Technology capacity was not reported or incomplete for the remaining public districts.
