

3301-16-06 Retaking end-of-course examinations.

- 1 (A) A student, who entered ninth grade for the first time on or after July 1, 2014, may retake any
2 end-of-course examination prescribed under division (B)(2) of section 3301.0712 of the
3 Revised Code during the student's academic career. The student may retake an exam during
4 the testing window(s) windows designated by the department of education and workforce.
- 5 (B) If a student does not take an end-of-course examination on the scheduled administration date,
6 the department of education and workforce shall make available to the student one of the
7 following at a later time in the student's academic career:
- 8 (1) The examination for which the student was absent; or
- 9 (2) A substantially similar examination. A substantially similar examination includes a
10 different version of the state ~~end-of-course test~~ end-of-course examination in the same
11 subject area.
