



## **Agriculture Education 5th Quarter Competitive Grant Overview**

**Summary:** Provides an overview of the grant purpose, general requirements, and timeline.

### **Description:**

The Agriculture Education Fifth Quarter Grant is a state-funded competitive grant to enable students in agricultural programs to enroll in a fifth quarter of instruction based on the agricultural education model of delivering work-based learning through supervised agricultural experience (SAE). Grant funds shall allow support of supervised agricultural experience that occurs anytime outside of the regular school day.

### **Requirements:**

Schools who are approved Career-Technical Education providers, committed to summer instructional activities with direct supervision of students by their teachers of agriculture may apply. The school must demonstrate a need for funds, complete the required [Comprehensive Continuous Improvement Plan \(CCIP\)](#) funding and planning tools of the grant through the OH|ID portal.

### **Dates:**

Funding for the grant begins July 1, 2021 and runs through June 30, 2022. Successful applicants may receive grant funding for FY22.

*\*The FY22 Agriculture Education Fifth Quarter Grants are subject to the state biennium budget approval.*

Applications for the Agriculture Education Fifth Quarter Grant FY22 will open Monday, May 3, 2021 and shall close Wednesday, June 30, 2021. Authorized Representative must approve the completed grant application on or before the application close date to be considered for funding.
