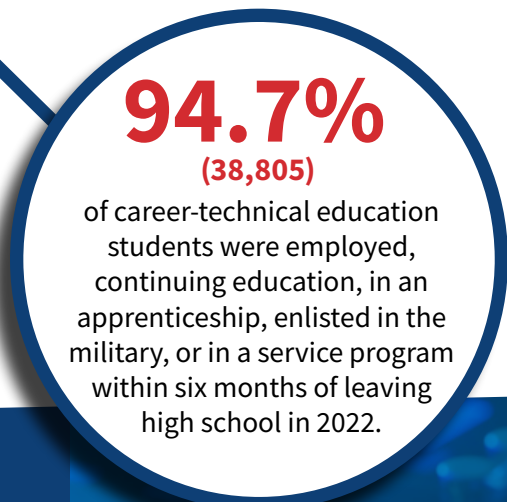

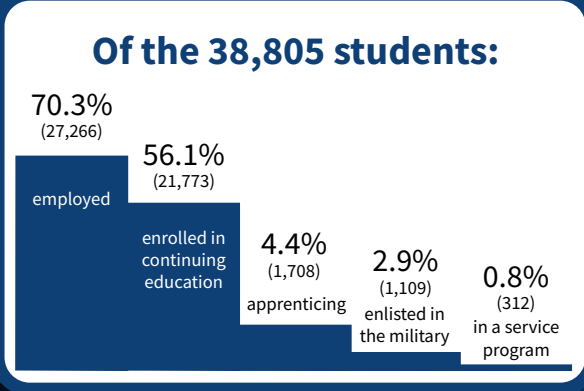

DID YOU KNOW?

79.7% (66,809) of career- technical education students scored **proficient or higher** on technical skill assessments.

136,691 students participated in career-technical education courses last year.

86,969 students were **concentrators** in a career-technical education pathway.

95.8% (41,262) of career-technical education students graduated in **2022**.

A **concentrator** is a student who has completed at least two courses in a single approved Career-Technical education program or program of study. Only one program of concentration can be reported by a district for each student in a year.
