

Identification of Community Schools at Risk of Closure

ELIGIBILITY:

All community schools who received a Traditional Report Card or a Dropout Prevention and Recovery Report Card in the 2022-2023 school year were subject to the business rules described below for identifying community schools at risk of closure.

The first set of criteria established in [Ohio Revised Code 3314.35](#), includes all eligible community schools except:

- any community school where the majority of students are enrolled in a dropout prevention and recovery program that is operated by the school; or,
- any community school in which a majority of enrolled students are children with disabilities receiving special education and related services; or,
- any community school that is in its first two years of operation

The second set of criteria established in [Ohio Revised Code 3314.351](#), includes:

- any community school in which a majority of the students are enrolled in a dropout prevention and recovery program operated by the school; and,
- any community school that is not in its first two years of operation

IDENTIFICATION CRITERIA FOR OHIO REVISED CODE 3314.35:

Community schools that serve any configuration of kindergarten, 1st, 2nd or 3rd grade, but no higher than 3rd grade, meet the criteria if they earn:

- A “1 Star” rating on the Early Literacy Component; **OR**
- An Overall Rating of less than “2 Stars”

Community schools that serve any configuration of 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, or 8th grade, but no higher than 9th grade, meet the criteria if they earn:

- A “1 Star” rating on the Achievement Component and a “1 Star” rating on the Community School Value-Added Measure*; **OR,**
- An Overall Rating of less than “2 Stars” and a “1 Star” rating on the Community School Value-Added Measure* This value-added measure is calculated for the purpose of closure and that it

The Community School Value-Added Measure is calculated for the purpose of identifying community schools at risk of closure. It uses value-added data from only the most recent school year and is calculated using only students the school has administered required assessments to for at least the two most recent school years.*

*** Required assessments are those prescribed by section 3301.0710 of the Revised Code*

only includes the most recent school year and only the assessment scores for students the school administered assessments to in the most recent two school years

Community schools that serve any configuration of 10th, 11th and 12th grade, meet the criteria if they earn:

- A “1 Star” on the Achievement Component and are considered to have “not met Annual Measurable Objectives” (implemented as earning a “1 Star” or “2 Star” rating on the Gap Closing Component); **OR**,
- An Overall Rating of less than “2 Stars” and a “1 Star” on the Community School Value-Added Measure*

IDENTIFICATION CRITERIA FOR OHIO REVISED CODE 3314.351:

Community schools in which a majority of the students are enrolled in a dropout prevention and recovery program operated by the school, meet the criteria if they earn:

- An Overall Rating of “Does Not Meet Standards”

The Community School Value-Added Measure is calculated for the purpose of identifying community schools at risk of closure. It uses value-added data from only the most recent school year and is calculated using only students the school has administered required assessments to for at least the two most recent school years.*
