





EMIS Data Appeals

- EMIS data appeals open immediately after each reporting window ends.
- Schools have about a week to file an appeal if they discover something is incorrect or incomplete.
- Form MUST be in the "SUPERINTENDENT APPROVED" status to be considered by the Department.
