Academic Performance Component

- Must align to the Ohio School Report Cards
- Based upon all applicable report card components
- Weighted by the number of students enrolled in each school in the sponsor's portfolio
- State law exempts schools open less than two full years and schools where a majority of the students have a disability






Overview Page: Traditional Report Card

Using Overall Report Card Ratings

For each school, the applicable components are combined into an overall report card rating.

This overall rating is a five-star scale, or a label of 'Exceeds Standards', 'Meets Standards' or 'Does Not Meet Standards'.

Ohio Revised Code 3314.016(B)(1)(a)

...The academic performance component shall be derived from the performance measures prescribed for the state report cards under section 3302.03 or 3314.017 of the Revised Code, and shall be based on the performance of the schools for the school year for which the evaluation is conducted. In addition to the academic performance for a specific school year, the academic performance component shall also include year-to-year changes in the overall sponsor portfolio...

Calculating the Average of the Two Portfolios

- Total Weighted Points for List A = 2.000
- Total Weighted Points for List B = 3.000

Average Weighted Points = (2.000 + 3.000) / 2 = 2.500

There is no document submission for the academic component of the sponsor evaluation cycle. This component is based entirely on report card data, so sponsors do not need to upload any documentation into Epicenter.

EMIS Data Appeals

- EMIS data appeals open immediately after each reporting window ends.
- Schools have about a week to file an appeal if they discover something is incorrect or incomplete.
- Form must be in the "SUPERINTENDENT APPROVED" status to be considered by the Department.


Data Quality Tool: Secure Data Center

- When schools submit data in EMIS, it can be seen in the Secure Data Center (SDC).
- The reports available in the SDC can be used to review and verify accuracy and completeness of reported data.
- The superintendent of each school receives access to the SDC and decides who else is granted access.
- SDC access is granted as a role in the Ohio Educational Directory System (OEDS).
