

EMIS Change 23-34: DD disability condition only for students 3-5 in PS
Public Comment open from March 7 through April 5

EMIS Change 23-34

This change reverses change 21-55, which was supposed to be a temporary change to EMIS validation checks due to COVID. State law only allows the DD disability condition (option 16) to be used for PS grade students who are ages 3-5. This change reinstates the EMIS validation check that only allows PS grade students who are ages 3-5 to be reported with the DD disability condition.

16 Developmental Delay

Reporting Instructions. Any student reported with a Disability Condition of “16” must be a pre-school student (grade level PS) and ages 3-5. ~~Preschool students who are 6 years old can only be reported with option “16” until December 1. As of December 2, 6-year-old preschoolers must be reported with an option other than “16”.~~ All kindergarten students regardless of age are to be reported with any disability condition not equal to “16 Developmental Delay”.
