The new GC Core Summary field to indicate financial literacy is all well and good, but there appears to be no good way to mark Career Tech students who are exempt from the FIN requirement. For example, in the FN250 (CORE Fine Arts Requirement Met), the only options to report are Y (District has determined that student has met this requirement) or N (District has not determined that student has met this requirement). Our Career Tech students will not have a FIN GC Core Summary record, and their FN250 field will be reported with No. Which is not an accurate reflection of their exempted status for Fine Arts Requirement.
