

**EMIS Change 25-166**

This change adds an option to the Type of Discipline Element. This new option is reflective of [Substitute House Bill 206 \(135th General Assembly\)](#). Additional items may be changed for FY26.

**May 29, 2025, update:** The Type of Discipline — Order of Severity table was updated incorrectly. The lefthand column is not the Type of Discipline options, it is the order of severity and should be 1 through 7 in order. To avoid confusion, the option numbers have been added to the righthand column.

**Reporting Instructions.** Multiple Types of Discipline are not to be reported for the same discipline incident.

Only report the most severe type of discipline for the specific incident. For example, if the student is suspended pending an expulsion for the same incident, only the expulsion is reported. The following table ranks the options in the Types of Discipline Element from most severe to least severe.

**Table 1. Type of Discipline – Order of Severity**

Severity Order	Type of Discipline Option
1	<del>6</del> –Emergency Removal by District Personnel
<u>2</u>	<a href="#">8–Expulsion Under Board Policy to Extend</a>
<del>3</del> <u>2</u>	<del>1</del> –Expulsion
<del>4</del> <u>3</u>	<del>7</del> –Removal by a Hearing Officer
<del>5</del> <u>4</u>	<del>2</del> –Out-of-school Suspension
<del>6</del> <u>5</u>	<del>4</del> –In-school Alternate Discipline Class/Program/Building
<del>7</del> <u>6</u>	<del>3</del> –In-school Suspension

In the circumstances where a student is expelled for possession of or bringing a firearm to school, the expulsion is still to be reported even if the chief administering officer chooses to modify the expulsion and/or refer the student for alternative educational services.
