Hi,

Could the driver's ed criteria be added to the EMIS manual so the requirements are listed along with the reporting guidance.

The additional information may help districts be sure they following the rules for types of drivers ed programs when collecting, coding, and reporting.

After reading, the drivers ed can only be used as a course credit for core graduation **-or**-industry credential – it cannot be used as both, correct?

Can DEW add a level 1 check if LEAs try to use the driver ed credit twice?

If not, can the following information be added to clarify that the drivers ed program must be a contract with the district (with directly or with a third party):

Driver Education Course

Ohio law now allows students to apply credit earned in a driver education course toward their high-school diploma requirements. A student who successfully completes a driver education course offered by their district may earn a half credit towards high school elective credits. The district must either directly offer or contract with a third-party that offers driver education. Students must have five elective credits, in addition to other required credits, to earn a high school diploma.
