This change updates EMIS Manual Section 5.3. An attribute is being added to indicate whether or not districts and schools provide information about and promote the college credit plus program. Note that this data has previously been collected via survey.

CCPDENIALS	Count of CCP students denied participation because they did not give notice of CCP participation by the deadline
CCPREIMBCT	Count of students who failed or dropped a course and districts sought reimbursement from the student for the cost of the course
CCPRESTITU	Total dollar amount a district is seeking for CCP reimbursement due to a dropped or failed course for all students (rounded to the nearest dollar)

Reporting Instructions. For these [three](#) College Credit Plus attributes, the Attribute Text is always the default value, spaces, and the Attribute Date is always the default value, 00000000.

[CCPPROINFO](#) is used to report whether or not districts and schools that educate grade 9-12 students provide information about and promote the College Credit Plus program. This reporting is at the district level, not the building level.

Valid Options

<u>A</u>	<u>District/school does not educate students in grades 9-12</u>
<u>N</u>	<u>No</u>
<u>Y</u>	<u>Yes</u>

Reporting Instructions. All districts and schools that serve one or more students in any of grades 9-12 are required to report either “Y” or “N” for this attribute. “Y” indicates that the district serves at least one student in any of grades 9-12 and *does* provide information about and promote the CCP program. “N” indicates that the district serves at least one student in any of grades 9-12 and *does not* provide information about and promote the CCP program.

[Entities that do not serve even one grade 9-12 student should report “A”.](#)
