Under Type of Discipline Element, the proposed change states. "Per OAC §3301-51-05, if a student with an IEP is removed for ten consecutive days or shows a pattern of removals totaling ten days in one school year, it constitutes a change in placement, and the manifestation determination review process must occur."

However, OAC 3301-51-05 states that a child has to EXCEED 10 consecutive school days or after a child has already served 10 days in the same school year, any subsequent days of removal would require the MD and services to be provided.
