Hi,

With the DL start date and FD attendance pattern and FS start date the Kindergarten age is start of school is identified in the data and ODEW EMIS could analyze the 3 day window (3 x number of hours) within the data currently reported to meet the minimum number of hours. Reporting additional attributes can create additional work and confusion to those coding and reporting this data.

Having the KG days (3 x hours from the DL) displaying on the Data Collector > Level 1 > Calendar Display report would be beneficial like ODEW adds the hours for professional development and PT conference hours so all hours counting and displaying transparency.

Also, on this note, could the senior 3 days (3 x hours from the DL) display on the Calendar Display report for data transparency so districts do not have to guess if their hours are given credit in the hours ODEW is using so the ODEW Finance office does not have to confirm with LEAs that hours are met using the 3 day senior option.
