## **Report Overview**

#### General Description and Significance

The State Funded Public Preschool Child Count Report serves as a data verification report for the reporting EMIS entity.

In addition, these data are used to determine the state-funded Early Childhood Education Grant (formerly State Funded Public Preschool Grant) head count as of December 1. This is the baseline for the Early Childhood Education Grant allocation the following school year. The Early Childhood Education head count is different from the federal Child Count for students with disabilities.

The purpose of the CSV files is data verification. They allow the districts to be able to verify/validate the Early Childhood data submitted for their district/buildings. One CSV file contains all of the Early Childhood data submitted by the district; it includes records for all students who pass the report selection criteria. The other CSV file contains all of the Early Childhood data for all students who have an "180250" COURSE CODE. If a district has traditionally use the Early Childhood Education Grant to support the enrollment of typically developing peers in the Preschool Special Education units, those students will be included in the counts for FY2007.

The printed report and the CSV\_CCYYP\_STUD\_ECE\_SF\_PPS include only those students in the preschool program serving children from income-eligible families. (See <u>EMIS Manual</u>, Appendix C, Subject Codes and Definitions for additional information on these definitions). The other CSV file includes all preschool students, i.e. students who pass the selection criteria.







## **ODE Processing**

#### **Process Description**

These reports are generated during the weekly EMIS processing cycle. Much of the data on the reports comes from the district's data files submitted during the week. Other data, as noted below, comes from the Office of Early Learning and School Readiness or the system process.

The data fields on the *Student Demographic* and *GRS (student) Course* records are used in the generation of this report. Note that there may be more than one GRS\_COURSE record for a student that needs to be evaluated for this report.

#### Data Source

The Office of Early Learning and School Readiness creates a file of the districts that receive these grant funds. It drives the program that pulls appropriate student data, basing the process on the IRN in the Early Childhood grant file.

Student demographic and student attendance data are aggregated into the **ASSG** file and stored in the **ADM\_INFO.RMS** file at ODE. Student course information is aggregated into the **ACGR** file which then becomes the **GRS COURSE.RMS** file at ODE.

**OEDS** is used for descriptive information about the district.

The **AUDIT** file is used to determine the date on which the data were submitted to ODE.

#### **Derived Data Used in Report**

There are no derived data used in this report but the file created by the Office of Early Learning and School Readiness is a necessary element in the report production.

#### **Report Selection Criteria**

If the STUDENT STATUS = "I" or "6", do NOT use the record.

If the STUDENT PERCENT OF TIME = zero, do NOT use the record.

If the STATE EQUIVALENT GRADE LEVEL = "PH" or "PS" or "PK", use the record, otherwise, do not.

If the DISABILITY CODE is "\*\*" or "11", use the record. There should be no other codes valid disability codes for this age group.

If the ADMISSION DATE is greater than December 1, 2006, do NOT use record.

If the ADMISSION DATE is less than December 1, 2006, AND

- If the WITHDRAWAL DATE equal to "00000000", use record OR
- If the WITHDRAWAL DATE is greater than or equal to the December 1, 2006, use record OR
- If the WITHDRAWAL DATE is less than the ADMISSION DATE, use record.



If a district has traditionally use the Public Preschool Grant to support the enrollment of typically developing peers in the Preschool Special Education units, those students will be included in the counts for FY2007.

## **Report Sample**

#### **Header Information**

The report/page header information contains helpful identifying information about the report and district itself. Data such as Program Name, Source Name, District IRN and name can be found in the upper left of the header, on each page of the report. The date, page, report period, Data Acquisition Site and Area Coordinator are in the upper right.

## Detail Information

- CHILDREN IN A STATE FUNDED PUBLIC PRESCHOOL PROGRAM WITH AN IEP
- OVER INCOME ELIGIBLE STUDENTS
- TOTAL

## Row (I) State Funded Early Childhood Education Grant 'Funded Number'

The funded number is the number of preschool children for which the entity is allocated funds through the state-funded Early Childhood Education grant. The Office of Early Learning and School Readiness use this number to determine the allocation of state grant dollars to the 112 entities in receipt of a state-funded Early Childhood Education Grant. This is line (I) on the report, and the source of this data is the business office.

## Rows (II - VII) Income Eligible Children

Income eligible children are those children who fall below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). Preschool children with no disability, (a DISABILITY CODE= "\*\*") <u>AND</u> with a COURSE CODE of "180250" are counted in a line of the report, according to POVERTY LEVEL reported. This includes lines (II) through (VII) on the report and lines (XI) and (XII) as well as any lines that summarize these counts. If a district has traditionally use the Public Preschool Grant to support the enrollment of typically developing peers in the Preschool Special Education units, those students will be included in the counts for FY2007.



- (II) Children at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level Preschool Poverty level reported = A
- (III) Children between 101% 125% of the Federal Poverty Level Preschool Poverty level reported = B
- (IV) Children between 126% -150% of the Federal Poverty Level Preschool Poverty level reported = C
- (V) Children between 151%-175% of the Federal Poverty Level Preschool Poverty level reported = D
- (VI) Children between 176%-185% of the Federal Poverty Level Preschool Poverty level reported = E
- (VII) Children between 186%-200& of the Federal Poverty Level Preschool Poverty level reported = F

#### Row (VIII) Total Income Eligible Children

• This count is the sum of children reported without a disability condition and with a PRESCHOOL POVERTY LEVEL = A, B, C, D, E, or F

Note: This should be a sum of the numbers reported in rows (II) through (VII)

#### Row (IX) Children in State Funded Early Childhood Education Program

This row (IX) of the report shows the number of children with a preschool disability condition who are enrolled in the state-funded Early Childhood Education program. Students are reported with the following:

- Course Code = "180250"
- DISABILITY CONDITION = "11"

## Row (X) Total of Row (VIII) + Row (IX)

This is the total number of students, both disabled and those who are income eligible, enrolled in the state-funded Early Childhood Education Program. In order to receive the maximum amount of Early Childhood Education Funding, this number must meet or exceed the Early Childhood Education 'Funded Number' found in row (I) at the top of the report.

## Rows (XI) - (XII) Over Income Children

This section shows the number of children, without disabilities, reported with preschool poverty options that are above 200% of FPL (Option G in the PRESCHOOL POVERTY LEVEL ELEMENT). It also shows if those number of children where no poverty information was provided.

(XI) Children above 200% of the Federal Poverty Level Student records reported with a "G" in the POVERTY LEVEL option.



#### (XII) Information Not Provided

Student records reported with a "P" in the POVERTY LEVEL option. This option is only applicable for students who are <u>not</u> supported by State Funded Public Preschool Grant dollars, i.e. students are counted on this line if they have a disability code of "\*\*" and a course code of "180250".

## **Row (XIII) Total Over Income Children**

This section shows the number of children who are over income and is the sum of lines (XI) and (XII).

## Row (XIV) Total of Row (X) + Row (XIII)

This is the total number of students counted in all of the rows of the report.

## Report, CSV files

There are 2 CSV files; they both have the same format. The difference in the file content is based on the filtering criteria.

.CSV\_CCYYP\_STU\_ECE\_SF\_PPS is a district-specific file of students with an "180250" COURSE CODE. No other students should be included on this file.

.CSVCCYYP\_STU\_ECE\_ALL\_PPS is a district-specific file of all students who pass the selection criteria, i.e. are preschool students.

Following is the file layout including field length for both the header and data rows. The data elements on each row are separated by a comma [','].

**Note** that the FY2007 record layout replaces the FY2006 fund source with up to three options on the student's course number.

#### EMIS Reporting Reminders and Tips

#### **Recipients of this Report**

Only those entities who are receiving state-funded Early Childhood Education Grant funds (as per the CCIP) receive this report. If am entity does not receive these grant funds, this report will not be generated. However, there is another data verification report available to any entity that submits preschool student data. It is in the form of a CSV file; called CSV\_CCYYP\_STU\_ECE\_ALL\_PPS.

#### **Changes Starting in FY2007**

The POVERTY LEVEL CODES have the same meaning under the current usage as they did in 2006 and the program continues to equate a specific line with the same POVERTY LEVEL CODE.

The following is a crosswalk between the old fund source codes and the current subject codes used for the Early Childhood data:

If the student has a Course Code of "180250", this student will be included on .TXT\_CCYYP\_STU\_SF\_PUBLIC\_PS, .CSV\_CCYYP\_STU\_ECE\_SF\_PPS, .CSV\_CCYYPP\_STU\_EXE\_ALL\_PPS. A student who had a fund source = "P" or "A" last year, should now have a course code of "180250" and should be included in all files regardless of whether or not that student was also enrolled in a "196095" course.

Once a student is determined to have this course code, any non-disabled student (disability code "\*\*") will be included in lines II-VII, VIII, X, and XIV if the Poverty Level is "A"-"F". If the disability code is "\*\*" and the Poverty Level is "N", the student is included in line XI and XIII. If the disability code is "\*\*" and the Poverty Level is "P", the student is included in line XII and XIII. These are the students who had "A" as their fund source in FY2006.

Any student with a disability code of "11" will be included in lines IX, X, and XIV. These are the students who had "A" or a "P" as their fund source in FY2006.



NOTE: the old "L" fund sources are  $\underline{not}$  included on the printed report;. This is a change from the FY2006 filters.

Students with a COURSE CODE of "180250", regardless of other conditions, are the ECE Grant students who should be included on .CSV\_CCYYP\_STU\_ECE\_SF\_PPS.

Students who meet the <u>selection criteria</u> (i.e., all preschool students), should be included on the .CSV\_CCYYPP\_STU\_EXE\_ALL\_PPS, and .CSV\_CCYYP\_STU\_ECE\_STATE\_PPS files. These students may or may not have an "180250" COURSE CODE.
