These reports are distributed to each district that reports data during a processing week of the year-end cycle.



ODE Processing

Process Description

These data come to ODE in the **YAAT (Year End Attendance)** file based on original data from the district's **GI (Student Demographic)** and **GK (Student Attendance)** files. The aggregation process accumulates counts from data submitted during each week of the year-end reporting



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cycle. After the data are accepted and incorporated into its *Year End Attend RMS* files, the report is generated.

Data Source

The primary source of these data is the **Year End Attend RMS** file which is derived from **GI** (**Student Demographic**) and **GK** (**Student Attendance**) records.

OEDS is used to provide header information for the report pages and to determine the output file name.

Records are selected from the Year End Attendance file if they have:

- YEAR END REC TYPE = "A"
- HOMELESS = "A", "B", "C", "F", "I", "J". "U"

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[&]quot;V" – Valid SSID - SSID is located on the IBM file

[&]quot;D" – Duplicate SSID (see SSID report documentation for further details)

[&]quot;O" - Valid SSID but found in district other than the one your district reported

[&]quot;A" - Attending Students

- STATE EQUIVALENT GRADE LEVEL = "PS", "PH", "PK", "KG", "KH", "01""13", "23"
- VALID SSID = "V", "D", "O"

Report Sample

Header Information

The first area of the header describes information about the report generation. The upper left section names the program from which the report was generated and the data source. The middle information identifies the producer of the report and the report title. The upper right section states the date on which the report was generated, the page number, and the reporting period to which the report belongs.

The second area of the header pertains to the recipient of the report. It identifies the district for which the report was produced, its IRN and COUNTY, the ITC and AREA COORDINATOR of the district.

That is followed by column headers indicating the type of counts reported on each detail line. These are the descriptions of the EMIS HOMELESS codes.

- A \rightarrow Homeless shelter
- $B \rightarrow Unsheltered$
- $C \rightarrow Doubled-Up$
- $F \rightarrow$ Abandoned
- I → Hotel/Motel
- $J \rightarrow Other$
- $U \rightarrow Unknown$

The last column header is the one for the total count by grade.

Detail Information

Each of the HOMELESS condition descriptions is listed horizontally, one column for each HOMELESS condition. Each of the GRADE LEVELS is listed vertically, one row for each grade. The counts are shown under their appropriate grade rows and homeless condition columns.

The right-most column is the Total by Grade, the sum of all of the columns for that row.



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The totals at the bottom of the page sum each column of the report. The last number on the report is the total count of students reported at all grade levels for all homeless conditions.

Error Detection and Correction

If the data on the report do not match the data anticipated by the district, district personnel should check any aggregation or EMIS error reports to determine whether or not all of the submitted data was accepted by ODE0.

The SSID .CSV file should be checked for VALID SSID fields that do not have a value of "V" or "O" or "D".

If these checks indicate no error conditions, districts should then check the HOMELESS field on their records. Other fields that might cause problems are those used in the selecting records for the report: STUDENT STATUS, ATTENDING/HOME IRN INDICATOR, and student GRADE LEVEL

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
