

Level 2 Report Explanation:

CCWMR Gap

The purpose of this report explanation is to provide districts with information about measures included in the College, Career, Workforce, and Military Readiness (CCWMR) component of the Local Report Card that cannot be found on existing reports or ODDEX exports.

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Function and Purpose

The CCWMR Gap Report is a Level 2 report that can be found in the Data Collector. The report identifies students who have achieved qualifying scores on an Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), or College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) exam, or have earned college credits.

The CCWMR Gap Report is identified in the Data Collector with the following name: (GRAD-004) CCWMR Gap.

Within the report, various result codes identify whether students achieved qualifying scores on an AP, IB, or CLEP exam, or if the student earned college credit.

If this report explanation—in concert with the EMIS Manual—does not answer your questions or help you to resolve your issues with the CCWMR Gap Report, then the normal path for getting help with EMIS reporting should be followed. The first point of contact should be the EMIS coordinator, followed by the Information Technology Center, then the EMIS Helpdesk, and finally Ohio Department of Education and Workforce (DEW) EMIS directly.

Process Description

A row is created for each student enrolled in a traditional district or community school who is assigned to a graduation cohort, has generated FTE in the current year, and has achieved one or more of the following:

- A score of 3 or higher on an AP exam
- A score of 4 or higher on an IB exam
- A passing score on a CLEP exam
- Earned college credits as reported on the Student Graduation–Core Summary (GC) Record

On this report, the Error Severity is set to “Informational” on every row.

Report

Layout and Fields

As with other Level 2 reports, it is possible to view the entire report or portions of the report by Severity Code.

Given the number of fields appearing on this report, a complete picture is not provided in this report explanation. Only the first columns appear in the table below; however, all fields are listed out below the table, with explanations or definitions provided as warranted.

SEVERITY CODE. A code that assigns a severity level to each record. The severity can be used by the viewer of the report to isolate any records that need particular attention. The only severity code displayed on the CCWMR Gap report is I-Information.

LEVEL 2 REC TYPE CODE. The name of the report.

RESULT CODE. Code indicating the component type. The table below shows the result codes and descriptions that are included in each report.

GRADE LEVEL. The current state equivalent grade level of the student.

COMPONENT NAME. The name of the component represented by this row: "AP" (Advanced Placement), "IB" (International Baccalaureate), "CL" (College-Level Examination Program), or "Dual Credit from GC Record".

COMPONENT COUNT. If the component type is "AP", "IB", or "CL", this column will display the count of exams for which a qualifying score was earned. If the component name is "Dual Credit from GC Record", this column will display the count of college credits earned.

COMPONENT DESCR. If the component name is "AP", "IB", or "CL", this column will display each assessment subject code for which a qualifying score was earned, separated by a semicolon. If the component name is "Dual Credit from GC Record", this column will display each CORE Area Code and associated dual enrollment credits, separated by a semicolon.

Appendix A

Information related to the remaining measures included in the College, Career, Workforce, and Military Readiness (CCWMR) component of the Local Report Card can be found in other Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) data exports and Level 2 reports in the Data Collector. The exports/reports related to each measure are listed below.

Remediation Free Scores ACT/SAT

Information on students who achieve a remediation free score on the ACT or SAT can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Competency Export.

If a student has achieved remediation free English and Reading scores on the ACT or a remediation free Reading and Writing score on the SAT, then the ENG_RMDTN_FREE_MET_FLAG will be 'Y' on the Competency Export.

If a student has achieved a remediation free Math score on the ACT or SAT, then the MATH_RMDTN_FREE_MET_FLAG will be 'Y' on the Competency Export.

Honors Diploma

Information on students who earn an Honors Diploma can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Readiness Export.

If a student has earned an Honors Diploma, then 'EARNED' will be displayed in the HONOR_DIPLOMA_STATUS_CODE column on the Readiness Export.

Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), and College-Level Examination Program (CLEP)

Information on students who earn qualifying scores on Advanced Placement (AP), International Baccalaureate (IB), and College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) examinations can be found on the (GRAD-004)-CCWMR Gap Report available in the Data Collector.

The Component Name column will indicate the type of exam taken.

The Component Count column will indicate the corresponding number of qualifying scores the student has earned.

Twelve or More Industry Credential Points in a Single Career Field or a State Recognized License

Information on students who earn 12 or more Industry Credential points in a single career field can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Competency Export.

If a student has earned 12 points in a single career field, then the IC_MET_FLAG will be 'Y' on the Competency Export.

If a student has earned 4 or more Industry Credential points in a single career field (but less than 12), then 'PLNPRG' or 'PRGNPL' will be displayed in the IC_STATUS_CODE column on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Readiness Export. This demonstrates progress towards this goal, either planned or not planned.

Information on students who earn a state recognized license can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Competency Export. If a student has earned a state recognized license, then the STATE_LIC_MET_FLAG on the Competency Export will be 'Y'.

Twelve or More College Credits

Information on students who earn 12 or more college credits can be found on the (GRAD-004)-CCWMR Gap Report available in the Data Collector.

If a student has earned college credits, then 'Dual Credit from GC Record' will be displayed in the Component Name column and the number of college credits earned will be displayed in the Component Count column.

Enlistment in the Military

Information on students who intend to enlist in the military can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Readiness Export.

If a student intends to enlist in the military, then 'EARNED' will be displayed in the MIL_STATUS_CODE column on the Readiness Export.

Completion of a Pre-Apprenticeship

Information on students who complete a pre-apprenticeship can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Competency Export.

If a student has completed a pre-apprenticeship, one of the following codes will be listed in the HIGH_EARNED_IC_ASESMNT_NAME column on the Competency Export: CT34, CT35, CT36, CT37, CT38, CT39, CT40, CT41, CT42, CT43, CT44, CT45, CT46, CT99.

Completion of an Apprenticeship

Information on students who complete an apprenticeship can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Competency Export.

If a student has completed an apprenticeship, then the APRNTC_MET_FLAG will be 'Y' and 'Completion' will be displayed in the APRNTC_TYPE_NAME column.

Acceptance Into an Apprenticeship Post-High School

Information on students who are accepted into an apprenticeship post-high school can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Competency Export.

If a student has been accepted into an apprenticeship post-high school, then the APRNTC_MET_FLAG will be 'Y' and 'Acceptance' will be displayed in the APRNTC_TYPE_NAME column.

Achieved Proficiency on Three or More Technical Assessments in a Single Career Pathway

Information on students who achieve an overall score of proficient or higher on 3 or more technical assessments in a single career pathway can be found on the (CTAC-001) CTE Technical Assessments Summary Report available in the Data Collector.

If a student has achieved an overall score of proficient or higher on 3 or more technical assessments in a single career pathway, then the sum of the GY ASESMNT COUNT, GW ASESMNT COUNT, and CCP USED COUNT columns will be 3 or greater and the PROF CODE will be 'P' (Proficient) or 'A' (Advanced).

Obtained an OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal and 250 Hours of Internship/Work-Based Learning

Information on students who earn the OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal and 250 hours or more of internship/work-based learning can be found on the Progress Towards Graduation (PTG) Readiness and Competency Exports.

If a student has earned the OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal, then 'EARNED' will be displayed in the OH_MEANS_JOBS_STATUS_CODE column on the Readiness Export.

If a student has completed 250 or more hours of work-based learning, then '250' or '500' will be displayed in the WBL_HOURS_RPTED_COUNT column on the Competency Export.
