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# Function and Purpose

The Students With Disabilities Issues Report is designed to help districts manage the reporting of students with disabilities within the current fiscal year and in some cases how it compares with prior years data. At this time, all traditional districts, community schools, and STEM schools receive a Students With Disabilities Issues Report, which is a Level 2 report and can be found in the data collector.

Within the report, result codes identify student-level data the district should review. Each report identifies specific situations defined by business rules where the reporting may not align to those required business rules. The intention of the report is to help districts identify reported data that may be unusual or may indicate an area warranting additional attention.

If this report explanation—in concert with the EMIS Manual—does not answer your questions or help you to resolve your issues with the Students With Disabilities Issues Report, then the normal path to getting help with EMIS reporting should be followed. The first point of contact should be the EMIS coordinator, followed by the Information Technology Center (ITC), then the EMIS Helpdesk, and finally Ohio Department of Education and Workforce (DEW) EMIS directly.

## Process Description

Each row on the Students With Disabilities Issues Report represents a district's most recently reported data in different areas.

Each row is assigned an Error Severity code, which is determined based on the consistency of district data across collection windows within the current fiscal year and in certain cases compared with the prior fiscal year.

## Reports

### Layout and Fields

The (STWD-001) Students With Disabilities Issues Report is a Level 2 report in the data collector. As with other Level 2 reports, it is possible to view the entire report or portions of the report by Severity Code.

Given the number of fields appearing on these reports, a complete picture is not provided in this report explanation. Only the first columns appear in the table below; however, all fields are listed below the table, with explanations or definitions provided as warranted.

**EDUC\_IRN (Educating IRN).** District IRN of the district educating the student.

**ERR\_SEV\_CODE (Error Severity Code).** This value is for technical purposes only and does not have an impact on any report values. It is used for separating data into different severity counts.

**ERR\_VALUE\_[1-3]\_TEXT (Error Value [1-3] Text).** These three columns are populated on this report when clarifying language or a data point is considered helpful to work the result code. These columns may not always have values populated.

**LEGAL\_DIST\_OF\_RES\_IRN (Legal District Of Residence IRN).** District IRN of the student’s legal district of residence.

**LEVEL\_2\_REC\_TYPE\_CODE (Level 2 Record Type Code).** Level 2 Record Type Code assigned.

**RESULT\_CODE.** Unique result code identifying district IRN or student who met the requirements of the check.

**RESULT\_CODE\_DESC (Result Code Description).** Description of the result code.

**RPT\_DEST\_IRN (Report Destination IRN).** District IRN receiving the Level 2 Report.

**SEVERITY CODE.** Every row on the Students with Disabilities Report will be assigned a Severity Code.

**SPECED\_EVENT\_OCCUR\_DATE (Special Education Event Occur Date).** The date an event occurred (Record Field Number: GE110).

**SPECED\_EVENT\_TYPE\_CODE (Special Education Event Type Code).** Identifies the outcome of an event (Record Field Number: GE120).

**SPECED\_OUTCM\_BEGIN\_DATE (Special Education Outcome Begin Date).** The date on which the outcome of the event became effective (Record Field Number: GE140).

**SPECED\_OUTCM\_CODE (Special Education Outcome Code).** Identifies the outcome of an event (Record Field Number: GE120).

**SPECED\_OUTCM\_END\_DATE (Special Education Outcome End Date).** The last day on which the outcome of the event will be effective (Record Field Number: GE150).

**SPECED\_RPTING\_IRN (Special Education Reporting IRN).** District IRN that has reported the special education event.

**SSID (Statewide Student Identifier).**
