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FUNCTION AND PURPOSE

All traditional districts, JVSDs, ESCs, community schools, and STEM schools receive a Where Kids Count Report, which is a Level 2 report that can be found in the Data Collector.

The Where Kids Count Report can be used by districts to verify which students will be included in accountability calculations for the Local Report Card and at what level (building, district, or state). This is based on Majority of Attendance (MOA) IRN reporting. Therefore, this report may be useful to district administrators as well as the district EMIS coordinator.

If this report explanation—in concert with the EMIS Manual—does not answer your questions or help you to resolve your issues with the Where Kids Count Report, then the normal path to getting help with EMIS reporting should be followed. The first point of contact should be the EMIS coordinator, followed by the Information Technology Center, then the EMIS Helpdesk, and finally ODE EMIS directly.

PROCESS DESCRIPTION

Each row on the Where Kids Count Report represents whether a student met the full academic year (FAY) criteria derived from the Student Standing (FS), Student Attributes – Effective Date (FD), and Student Attributes – No Date (FN) Records.

When the MOA IRN and the Accountability IRN contain different *building* IRNs within the district, the Accountability IRN will be used to populate the Where Kids Count (WKC) IRN. For all other conditions, the MOA IRN will be used to initially populate the WKC IRN.

Once an initial WKC IRN determination is made, a series of adjustments are then considered using the Student Standing (FS) and Student Attributes – Effective Date (FD) Records that are in effect as of March 31 of the current school year. See the Result Code table for more information regarding adjustments.

REPORT

Collections and Records

In general, this report will include the most recently reported data. The records used include the Student Standing (FS), Student Attributes—Effective Date (FD), and Student Attribute – No Date (FN) Records. From these, the elements in *Table 1* are used.

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Layout and Fields

The Where Kids Count Report is a Level 2 Report in the Data Collector. The report name is (WKCD-001) Where Kids Count. As with other Level 2 reports, it is possible to view the entire report or portions of the report by Severity Code.

RESULT DESCR (Result Code Description). The Result Code Description indicates why the WKC IRN assignment is either a building IRN, a district IRN, or *****. The table below includes all possible WKC Result Codes, along with the description, adjustment explanation, and WKC Level details.

WKC IRN (Where Kids Count IRN). Indicates where the student will count as determined by the Department based upon data reported through EMIS.

ATNDNG ORG IRN (Attending Organization IRN). The Attending Building IRN as reported in the Student Standing (FS) Record (see EMIS Manual Section 2.4).

ASSGN ORG IRN (Assigned Organization IRN). The Assigned Building Area IRN as reported in the Student Standing (FS) Record (see EMIS Manual Section 2.4).

WKC CODE (WKC Type Code). Indicates the WKC Type Code that corresponds to the assigned Result Code. The WKC Type Codes are no longer used (since the implementation of the Result Codes) and will be removed in a future version.

MAJORITY OF ATTND IRN (Majority of Attendance IRN). The Majority of Attendance IRN as reported in the Student Attributes – No Date (FN) Record (see Section 2.6 of the EMIS Manual).

ACNTBL IRN (Accountability IRN). The Accountability IRN as reported in the Student Attributes – No Date (FN) Record (see Section 2.6 of the EMIS Manual).

LEP CODE (Limited English Proficiency Code). The Limited English Proficiency Code as reported in the Student Attributes – Effective Date (FD) Record (see Section 2.5 of the EMIS Manual).

STATE EQUIV GRADE LEVEL CODE (State Equivalent Grade Level Code). The State Equivalent Grade Level as reported in the Student Attributes – Effective Date (FD) Record (see Section 2.5 of the EMIS Manual). Preschool students are not included in this report.

ENRL REASON CODE (Enrollment Reason Code). The How Received Code as reported in the Student Standing (FS) Record (see Section 2.4 of the EMIS Manual).

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FORGN EXCHG GRAD PLAN CODE (Foreign Exchange Graduation Plan Code). The Foreign Exchange Student Graduation Plan as reported in the Student Attributes – Effective Date (FD) Record (see Section 2.5 of the EMIS Manual).

RELEVANT SENT REASON (Relevant Sent Reason). The Sent Reason of AU, CT, JP, JV, MR, OS, or PS as reported on the Student Standing (FS) Record (see Section 2.4 of the EMIS Manual).

STDNT STAND START DATE (Student Standing Start Date). This is the date as reported on the Student Standing (FS) Record (see Section 2.4 of the EMIS Manual).

STDNT ATTRIBS START DATE (Student Attributes Start Date). This is the date as reported on the Student Attributes – Effective Date (FD) Record (see Section 2.5 of the EMIS Manual).

ERR SEV NUM (Error Severity Number). This value is for technical purposes only and does not have an impact on any report values. It is used for separating data into different severity counts.

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
