## EMIS Focused Training – Gifted Q & A December 2023

Below are some of the questions that were asked during the EMIS Focused Training – Gifted sessions held on December 4 and 7, 2023. The questions are in order by topic and include the answer and, in many cases, a link to EMIS documentation where the information can be found. Note that the <u>EMIS Manual</u> continues to be the authoritative source for EMIS reporting guidance.

## **Data Reporting**

Q1	What does the March 31	reporting	deadline	pertain to	in terms	of the	report card?

- A1 To be deemed identified for the current year's report card, a student must be identified no later than March 31 of that school year. Data does not need to be reported in EMIS by March 31; this simply means the district must have the test score showing the student met the criteria to be identified as gifted no later than that date. Students identified on April 1 or later will be included in their school and district's calculation for the first time in the following school year. See 2022-2023 Gifted Performance Indicator Technical Documentation.
- **Q2** Should a teacher teaching gifted and regular courses be reported with the 999380-Gifted and Talented or 999370-General Education K-12 Assignment Area (CK220) code?
- A2 This teacher should be reported with two Staff Employment (CK) Records one for each position. See <u>EMIS Manual Section 3.4</u>.
- **Q3** What does the resident/sending district report for gifted students enrolled in a gifted course or receiving gifted services at a career center?
- A3 The resident/sending district only reports identification on the Student Gifted Education (GG) Record in the appropriate Gifted Identified (GG4xx) elements, but they report N in the Gifted Served (GG5xx) elements. The career center reports the services gifted course enrollment and/or gifted program codes but does not report the gifted record. See EMIS Manual Sections 2.9, 2.10, and 4.2.
