Student English Learner Status (ENRL-003)

- Generated the first week of May 2023
- Report Purpose: Designed to help districts manage the reporting for students who are English learners.
- Identifies students who:
 - -Are close to or exceeded the duration of being reported in a specific English Learner Status Element (FD170);
 - –Have a conflict between the English Learner Status Element (FD170) and an OELPA administration and/or OELPA proficiency;
 - -Have a conflict between the English Learner Status Element (FD170) and the Student Home Language Element (GI570) reported.





Student English Learner Status Data Used

- Prior year OELPA proficiency
- Current year OELPA test
- EL status reported in prior and in the current year
- Prior years and current year FTE
 - -Total prior years FTE
 - -Also include current year
 - -Generate error based on when they hit 1.0 or 2.0 FTE
- Was Home Language reported?

- GRAD Students who graduated in the prior fiscal year Small ODE revisions in students included based on Grad Appeals
- SWD Students identified with a disability condition who left secondary education in the prior fiscal year. ODE is removing students who have not reached grade 9 ODE is removing students who are 'services only'

Potential College Credit

- Expected Summer 2023
- Report Purpose: Provide districts with the possible assessments and/or courses that may qualify for dual credit for students.
- For the students in the current FY grad cohort, compares reported dual credit (GC) against the potential credits in 3 areas:
 - -CTAG (Career Technical Assurance Guide)
 - -AP/IB assessments
 - -CCP courses

Potential College Credit

Advancement Placement/International Baccalaureate assessments

- Reported with an AP/IB assessment
- Test score equal to or greater than 2
- Did the student enroll in a college that gave them credit?

CCP courses

- Institute of Higher Education provides list to ODE of students who have enrolled in CCP eligible course and credits
- Did the student pass the course and earn the credit?

• CTAG

- Institution of Higher Education provides list to ODE of eligible course and credits
- Students must also have CTE Technical Assessment reported which aligns to the course reported
- Did the student enroll in a postsecondary institution where the credit was transcripted?

- Expected Summer 2023
- Report Purpose: Provide districts with students' aligned courses that do and do not count towards a CTE Concentrator status.
- Elements included course:
 - Reporting LEA IRN
 - FY of the course
 - -Local Classroom Code
 - Reported HS credits
 - Percent time enrolled







Resident Stdnt Edu Elsewhere (ENRL-001)

- Completed April 2023
- Report Purpose: Rows on the Resident Students Educated Elsewhere Report are generated when a student is reported as being educated at a different LEA than the student's resident district.
- 2 New Result Codes:
 - -EN0006 Resident student enrolled in the Autism Scholarship Program (I)
 - -EN0007 Resident student enrolled in the Jon Peterson Scholarship program (I)

Moving the Data Collector to OHID

- Plan to make this change this fall

- Lots of local control
