Responsibilities

- The involvement EMIS Coordinators will have for new modules
 - –Reporting of needed EMIS data to ODE and SSDT
 - -All modules will use the data from various collections
 - -Serving as a general resource on how ODDEX works
- EMIS Coordinators are not expected to be the primary users of any of the modules we are discussing today



Child Nutrition Direct Certification (CNDC)

- National School Lunch Program certification process
 - –Not new to districts, only new to ODDEX
 - -Legacy CNDC UI was not user friendly
 - Cumbersome
 - Time consuming
 - -Repetitive work required
 - Much of data users uploaded each month existed in EMIS







Education

Access to CNDC

- Access to ODDEX/CNDC is obtained when your district's OEDS Administrator grants roles
 - -Generally roles will be granted to district Food Service personnel
 - -Verifier-CNDC
 - Allows user to manually match, unmatch and remove eligibility for students
 - -Data View-CNDC
 - Allows user to view data





Education

CNDC

- Login point is at OHID for all users
- Leverages EMIS reported data for all enrolled students
 - -Student Cross Reference (SCR) data
 - -Earlier submission of SCR data by non-CEP districts needed
- Districts can improve their match and certification rate
 - –Districts can submit address and guardian information thru EMIS contact collection request
 - -Upload is optional to include the same data



CNDC

- Potential students eligible for Free and Reduced benefits are provided by
 - –Ohio Department of Job and Family Services
 - -Ohio Medicaid
 - –Data only used for child nutrition benefits
 - To use data for economic disadvantagement in EMIS for local **purposes**, parent or guardian must give permission in writing
 - Can identify students as ED for state/federal EMIS reporting

- Initial challenges with OHID
- May need help with creating a local ID/SSID crosswalk file
- Data corrections

–Never Foster, Homeless, Migrant

- Support- Department's Child Nutrition office and wiki
- Need easier way to handle 81's possible FY25 change



Progress Towards Graduation (PTG)

- Tool to provide access to a student's graduation progress
 - -Competency
 - -Readiness
 - -Courses
- Data for students enrolled or students claimed
- Guidance or enrollment staff
- Navigation Bar









PTG

- Leverages data reported to EMIS in various collections
 - -Beginning, middle and end-of-year
 - -Grad Credit Progress
 - -Staff and Course
 - -End-of-course, Career Tech, Alt Assessments, Other Accountability Assessments





PTG

- Data Sources
 - -GI, FS, FD (general enrollment and subgroups)
 - -GC (credits towards graduation)
 - -GQ (grad seals, WBL, alternative competency)
 - -GE, FE (exemptions for EOC assessments)
 - -FA (competency and seals)
 - -CN, GN (alternative competency)



Education

Access to PTG

- Access to ODDEX/PTG is obtained when your district's **OEDS** Administrator grants roles
 - -Data View-PTG
 - -Superintendent
 - -Treasurer, Business Manager, Assistant Treasurer
 - -Coordinator-EMIS, Supervisor-EMIS, Director-EMIS
 - –Data View-ODDEX Records Grad
 - –ITC staff with SDC access
 - Have access by default, no special roles are needed

- If something does not seem correct on a report, use to determine if the right data has been submitted

PTG

- Rollout will begin this month
- Will start with credit reports
- By end of fall, all reports will be available and reflect all data for this school year
- Major promotion and training for the field in the fall





Early Warning System (EWS)

- Module to assist districts in identifying students that may be at risk to not graduate on time
- Guidance staff
- Available in ODDEX during the 2023-24 school year





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Access to EWS

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 - -Coordinator-EMIS, Supervisor-EMIS, Director-EMIS
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EWS

- Data Sources
 - -GI, FS, FD (demographics, attendance)
 - -CN, GN, FR (course grades)
 - -GQ (extracurriculars)
 - -GD (suspensions and expulsions)



EWS Indicators

- Three high level indicators of students who should be examined regarding graduation risk
 - –Absent for 10% of school
 - -Have a suspension
 - -Failing grades
- In addition to statewide criteria on these items, each district will be able to configure their own threshold



EWS Risk Levels

- In addition, the system will assign a graduation risk level (low, medium, high, ultra) based on points assigned in several areas
- Points in some areas are all-or-nothing, others vary by the amount
- In addition to areas with indicators, includes some demographic information, assessment performance, years retained in school, number of buildings attended, and extracurriculars (lack of)





- System will be released this fall
- Will be important to keep data up to date for the system
- Same data dictionary will be provided for this module
