

EMIS Focused Training – Exiting Student Follow-Up Q&A: October 2025

Below are some of the EMIS reporting questions that were asked during the EMIS Focused Training – Exiting Student Follow-Up sessions held on October 22 and 24, 2025. The questions are grouped by topic and include the answer and, in many cases, a link to EMIS documentation where the information can be found. Student Groups

- Q1** *Which entity would be responsible for follow-up reporting for a student who was a concentrator at a JVS and also a student with a disability?*
- A1** The JVS will report CTE follow-up data since they are the entity where the student was last a CTE Concentrator. The district responsible for FAPE will report Students with Disability follow-up data. See the [Exiting Student Collection webpage](#).

- Q2** *Would an open-enrolled student with a disability reported with Withdrawal Reason 41 be excluded from follow-up reporting?*
- A2** No. Withdrawal Reason 41 is not among the options that exclude a student from follow-up reporting. See the [Exiting Student Collection webpage](#).

- Q3** *Should a student who withdrew last year from our district and then enrolled in another district this school year be included in our district's (FLUP-001) Exiting Students Follow Up Extract (All Students) Report?*
- A3** If the student is generating FTE in the current school year at another district, they will appear in your district's FLUP-001 with Result Code FP0004, indicating the student has been removed. See the [\(FLUP-001\) Exiting Students Follow Up Extract \(All Students\) Report Explanation](#).

- Q4** *Should a student who was reported as withdrawn with a 7x Withdrawal Reason be excluded from follow-up reporting?*
- A4** No. Withdrawal Reason 7x options do not exclude a student from follow-up reporting. See the [Exiting Student Collection webpage](#).

Data Reporting

- Q5** *If one district is responsible for CTE follow-up and another for Grad follow-up for the same student, can the Grad-responsible district use the first district's follow-up responses?*
- A5** No. Districts should only include information about a former student if they learn it from their own contact with the student or from an adult with direct knowledge of the student's follow-up status. See [EMIS Manual Section 2.23](#).

- Q6** *Should an Employment Career Field (FW170) option be reported for a CTE follow-up student, even if their employment is not related to their program of concentration?*
- A6** Yes. The career field that best describes the area of employment should be reported. See [EMIS Manual Section 2.23](#).

Level 2 Reports

- Q7** *Should a student on the FLUP-001 report with Result Code FP0004 be removed from the report, or just not included in follow-up reporting?*
- A7** The student will remain on the FLUP-001 report with Result Code FP0004, but the district should not report any follow-up date for that student in the Exiting Student Collection. See the [\(FLUP-001\) Exiting Students Follow Up Extract \(All Students\) Report Explanation](#).
