Admission date reporting:

A change in a student’s district relationship from “2” to “1” or from “3” to “1” is considered a re-entry and requires a new admission date to be reported that reflects the date on which the student began receiving instruction. For students who were reported by the district at the end of the previous school year, the district should continue to report the admission date as it is currently being reported as long as there is no change in the district relationship from “2” to “1” or from “3” to “1”. If there is a change in the district relationship from “2” to “1” or from “3” to “1” then a new admission date must be reported following the existing rules for reporting the date (for example, the date cannot be on a day in the school’s calendar unless the student begins attendance on that day). Note that a change in a student’s district relationship from a “1” to “2” or from “1” to “3” does not require a new admission date to be reported.
