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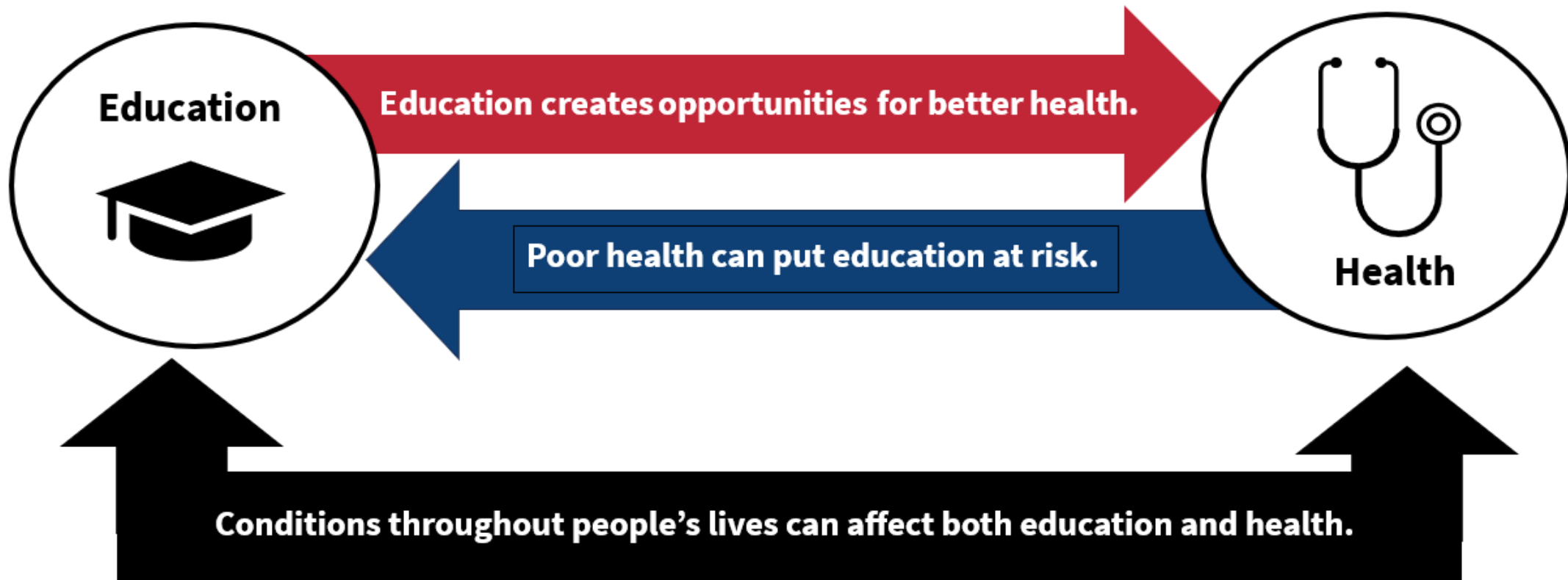

# What are the Healthy Student Profiles

- Statewide data tool summarizing student health interactions, health conditions and education indicators.
- Supports school and district planning and collaboration.
- Provides consistent measures for comparison.
- Medicaid claims collected.
- Public Schools.
- Building and district level data available.

# Healthy Student Profiles Data

- K-12 who participated in Medicaid for at least 3 months
- If enrolled for at least 100 hours
- Building and district level with county and state level comparison data

# Excluded from Profiles

- Student-based measures
  - Must have at least 30 students in the denominator.
- Health & Education measures
  - Fewer than 11 students in the numerator are fully suppressed.

# Healthcare Interactions

- Comprehensive well-child visit
- Primary care physician visit
- Primary care physician visit, within 2 years
- Dental care visit
- Dental care visit, within 2 years
- Trip to emergency department
- Overnight stay at general hospital



# Health Conditions

- Asthma
- Diabetes
- Any behavioral health condition
  - Serious mental illness
  - Autism
  - Major depression
  - Depression (all)
  - Anxiety
  - Attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder
  - Substance use disorder
  - Severe Emotional Disturbance

Counselors

Nurses

Psychologists

Social Workers

- Rates are available at the district level per 100 students
- Rates do not necessarily represent the degree to which schools have regular access to these professionals

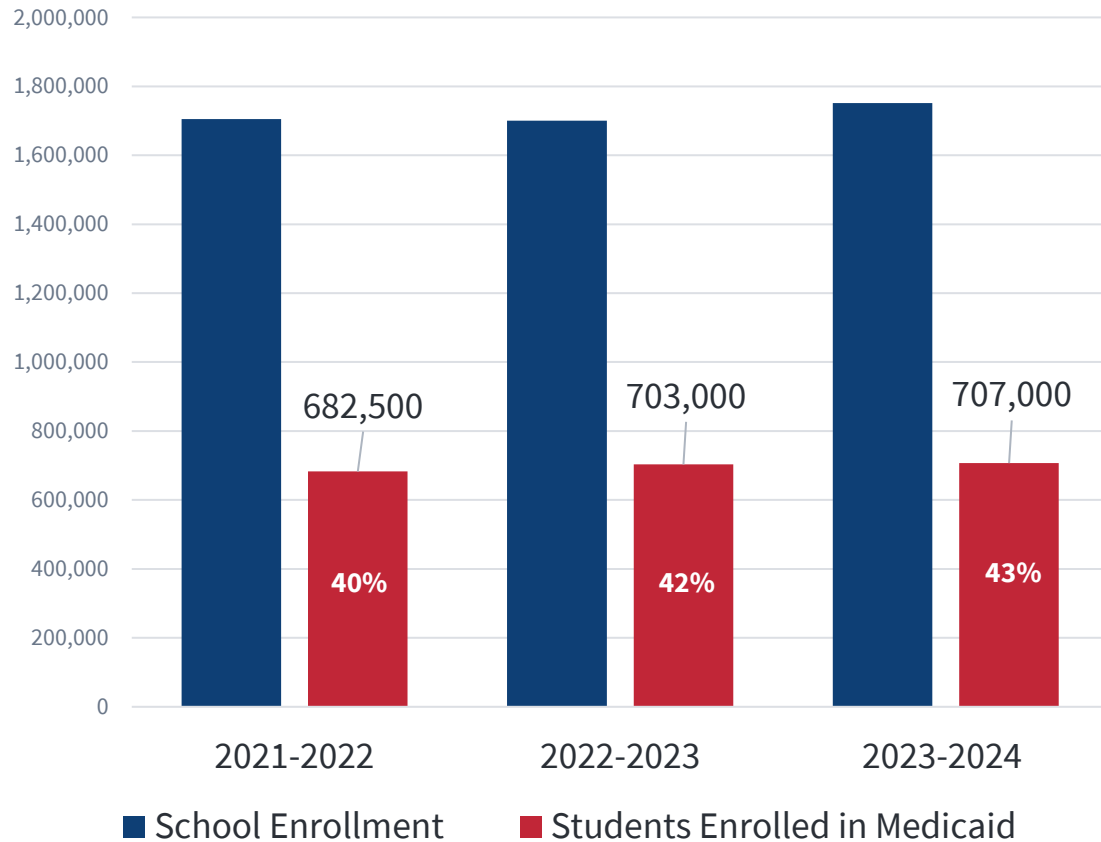

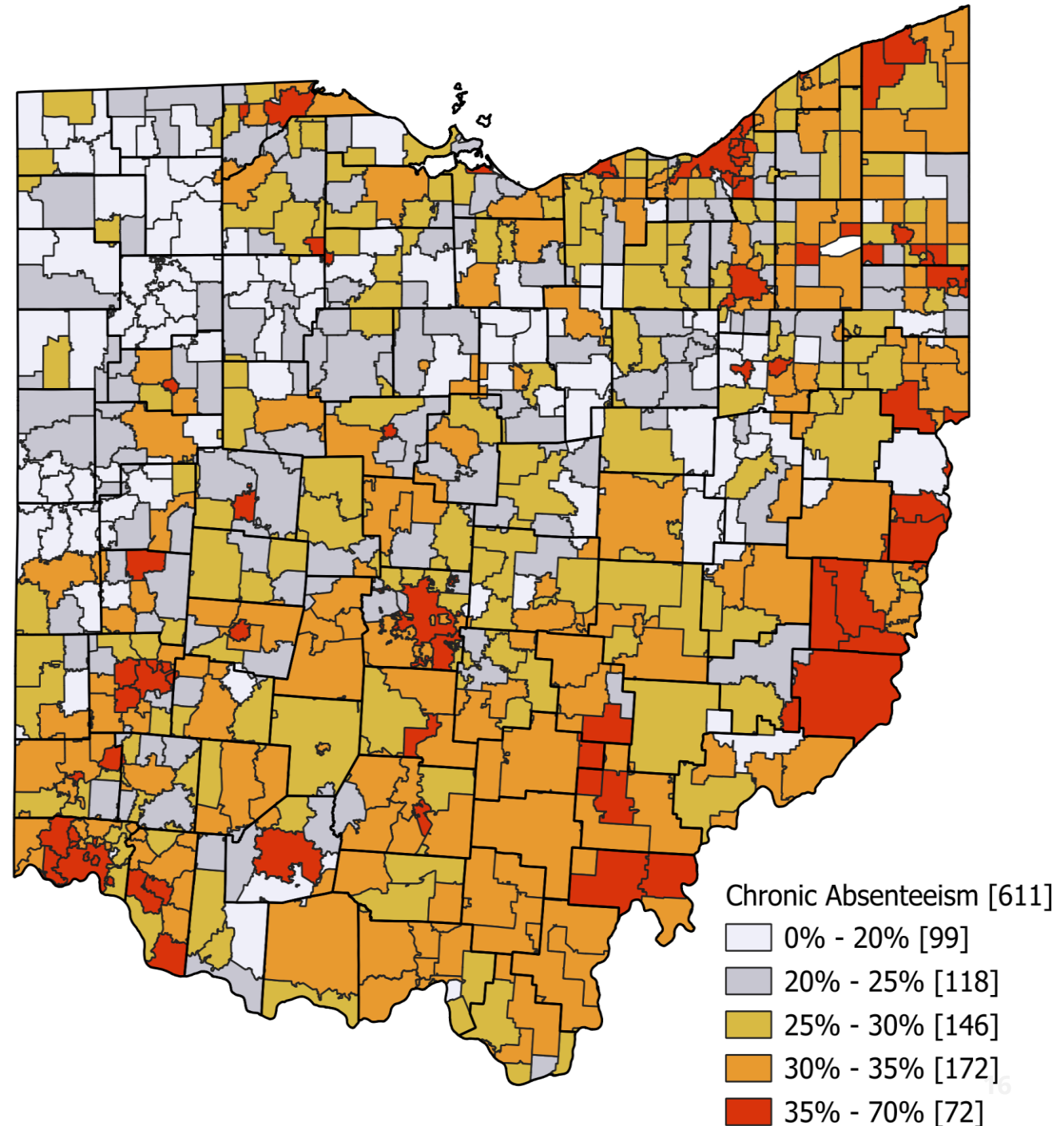

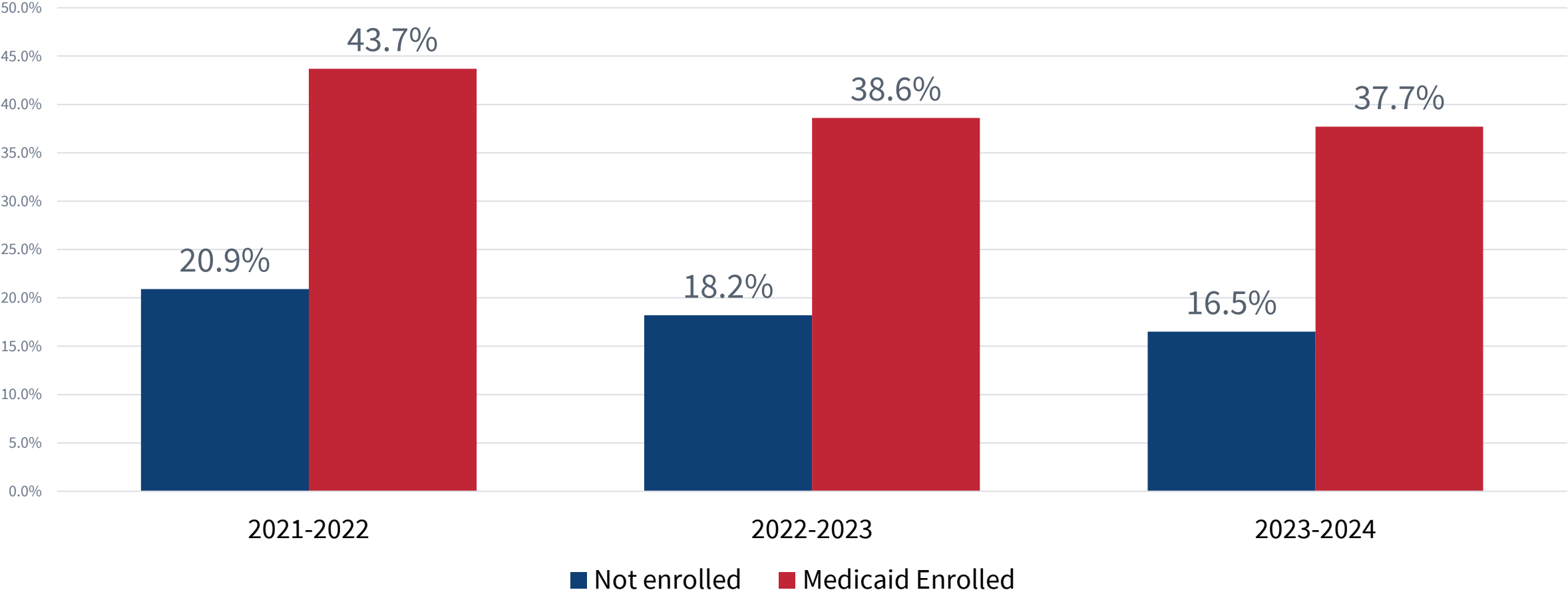
# Spotlight: Chronic Absenteeism

Percent of Medicaid students chronically absent

- 37.7% Chronically absent.
- 390 Districts had chronic absenteeism rate for student on Medicaid greater than 25%.



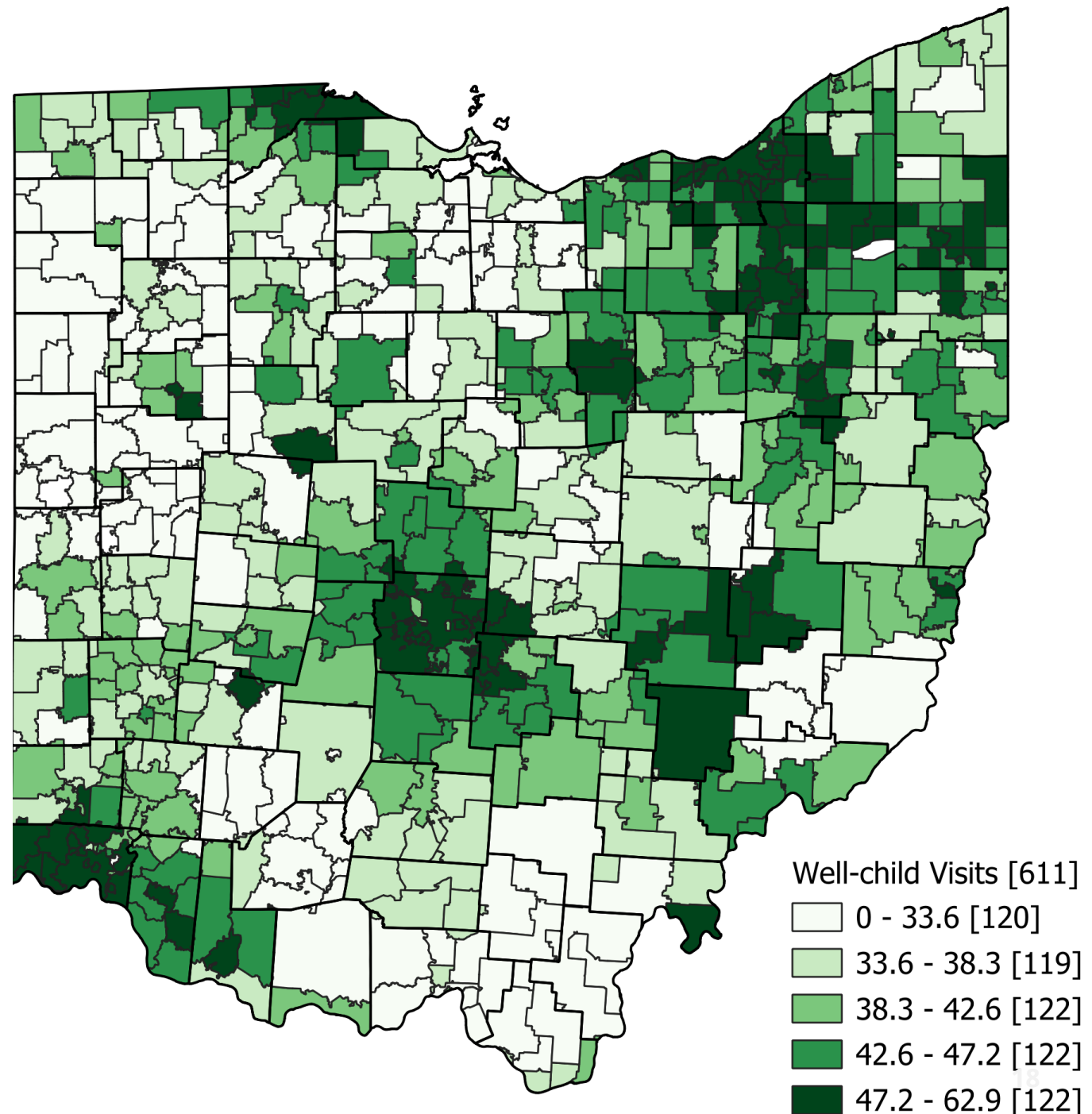
# Chronic Absenteeism Healthy Student Profile Data



# Spotlight: Preventive Care- Well child visit

Percent of Medicaid students who received well-child exams in last year

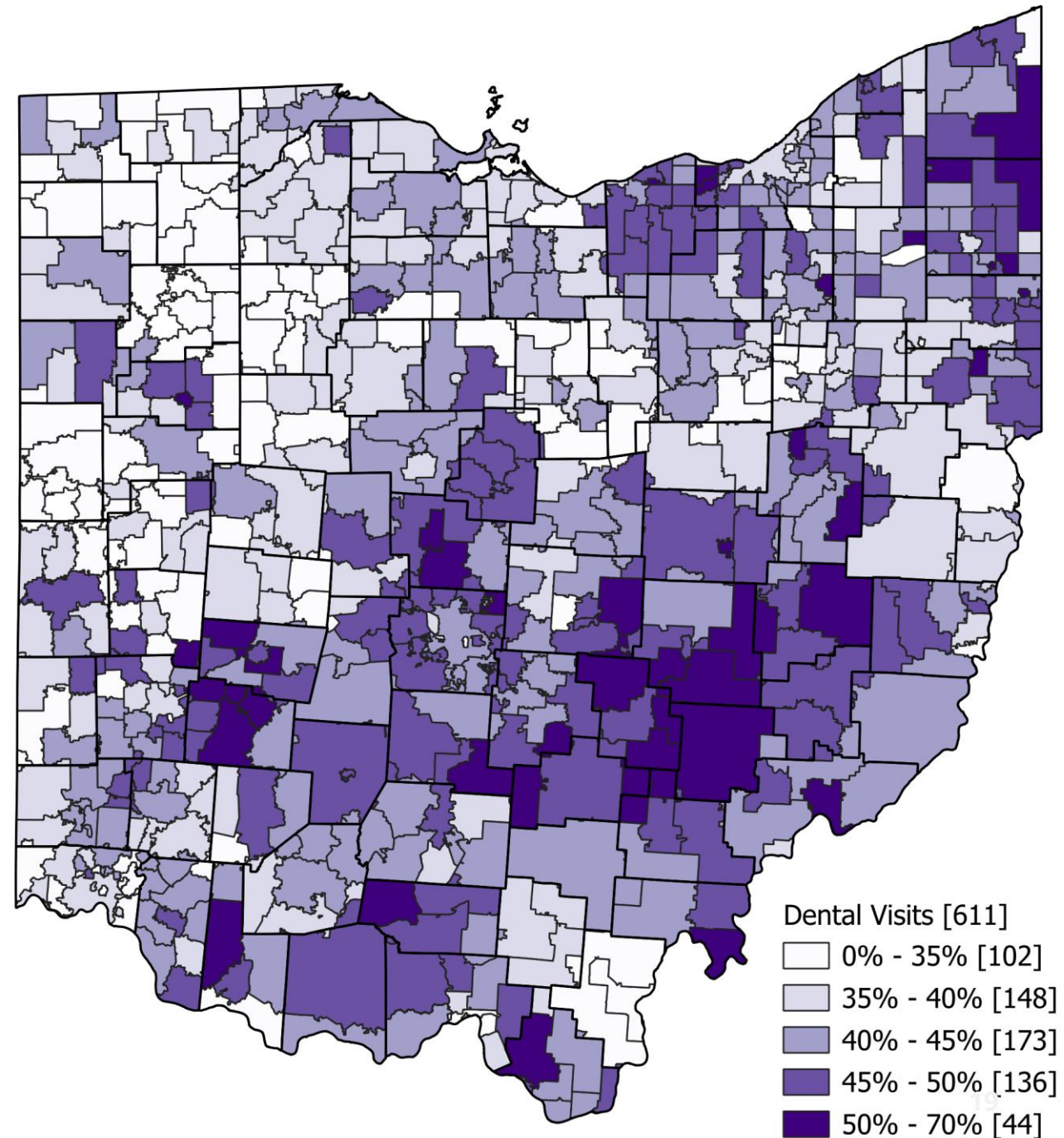
- 43.2% had an annual comprehensive well-child checkup.
- Over 400,000 Medicaid students missed this annual check up.



# Spotlight: Dental Visits

Percent of Medicaid students who had a dental exams in last year

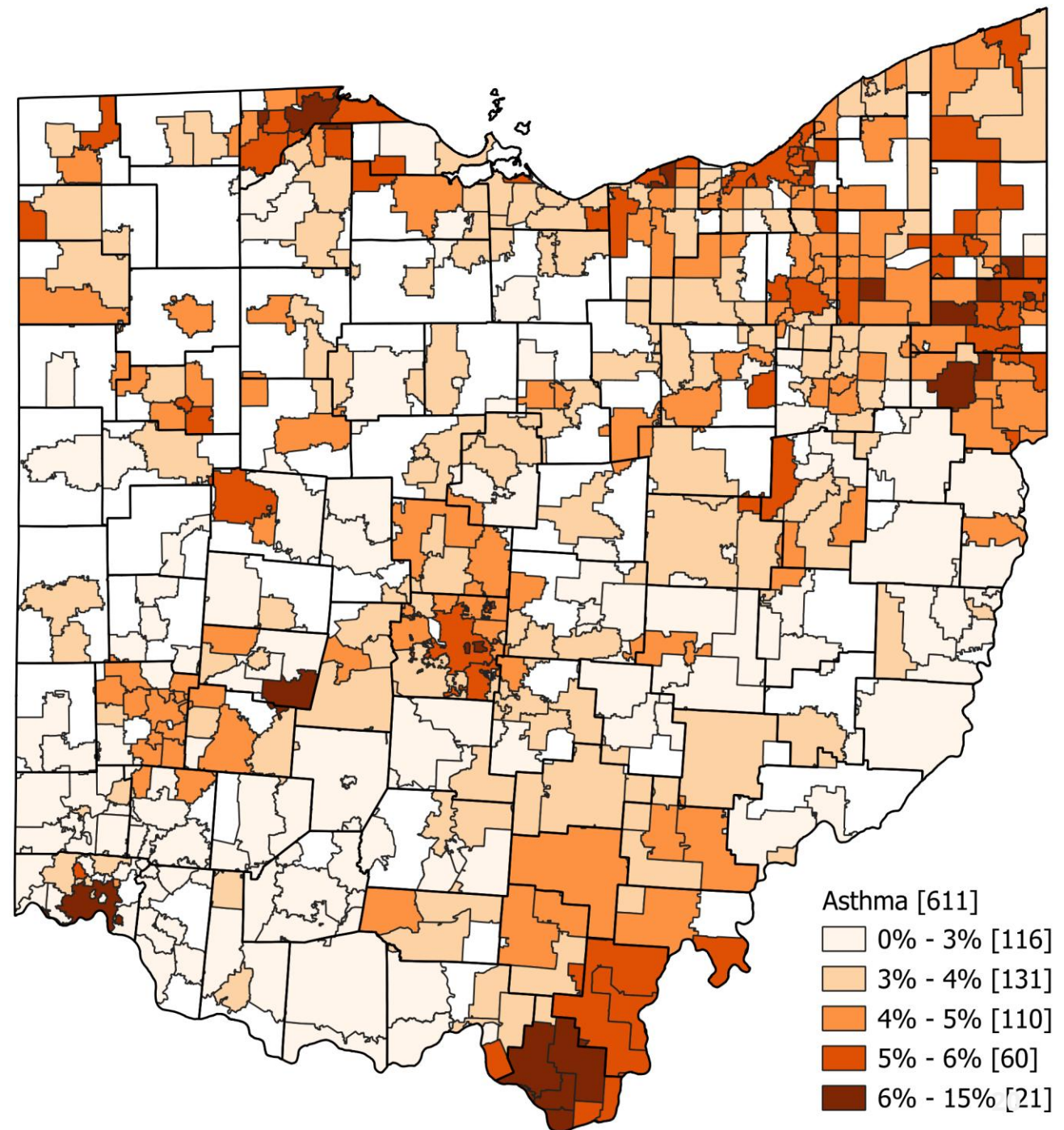
- 567 districts- less than 1/2 student participating in Medicaid had dental exam in the last year.
- Only 1/3 of high schoolers (34.9%) saw a dentist.

Percent of Medicaid students with a diagnosis of Asthma

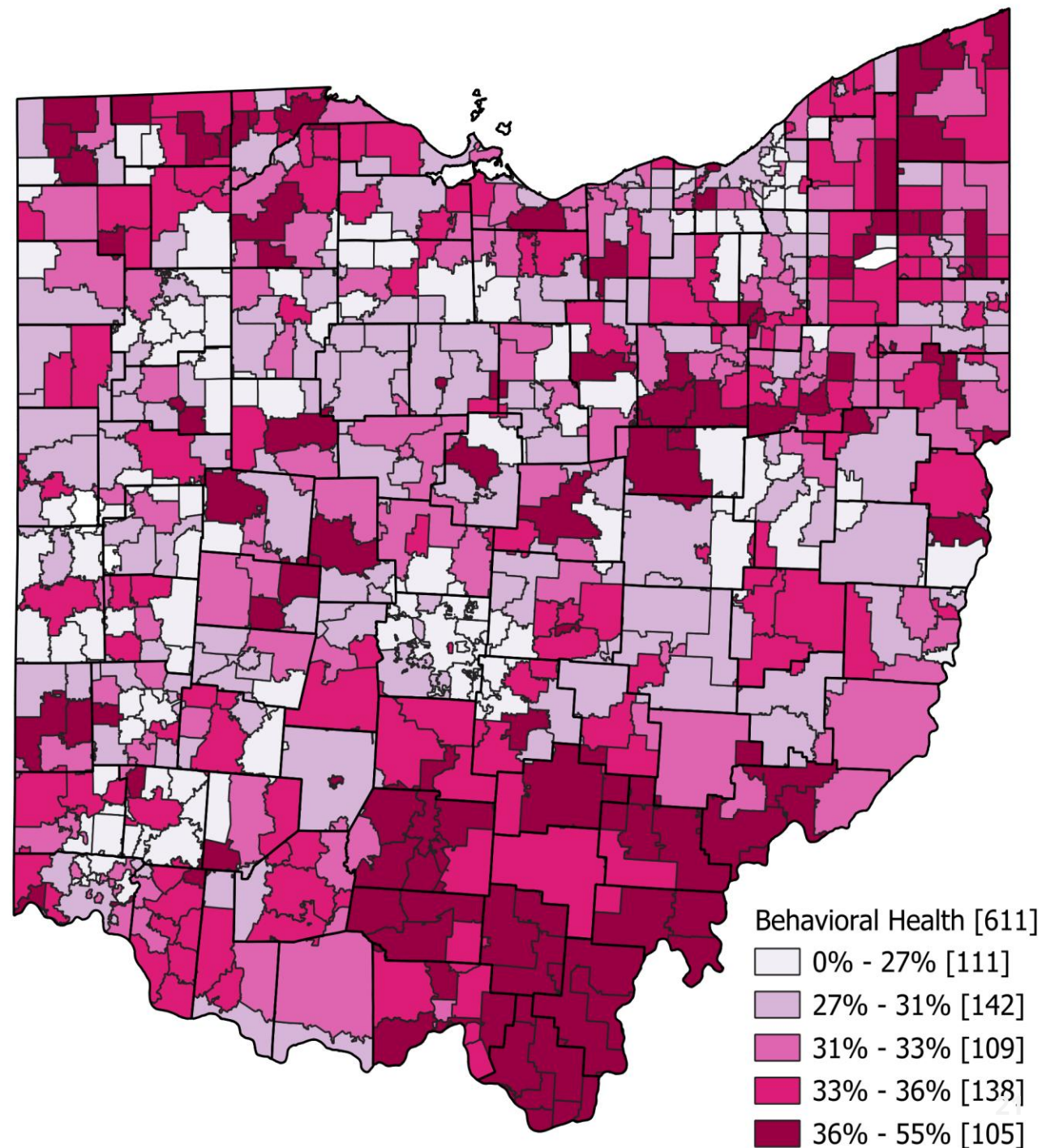
- 4.2% Asthma rate

# Spotlight: Any Behavioral Health Condition

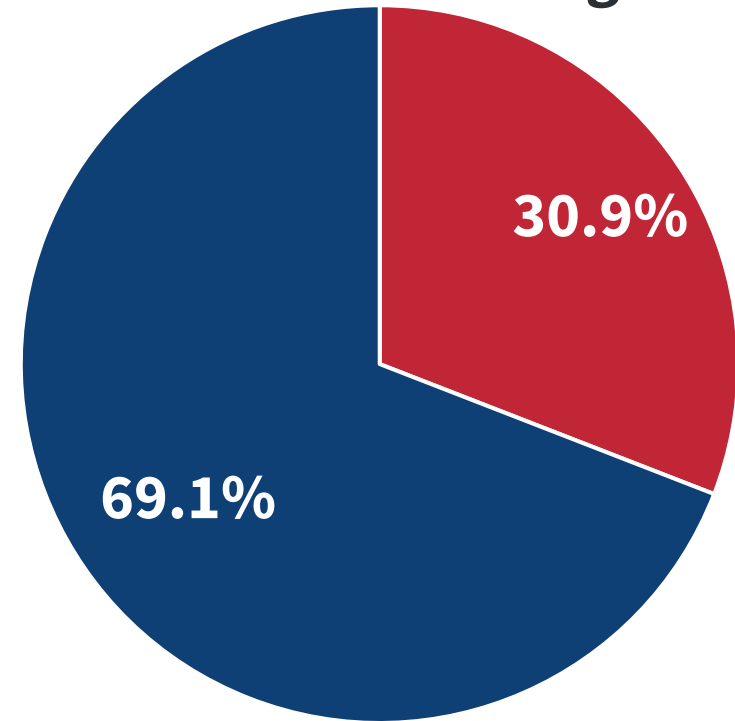
Percent of Medicaid students with a behavioral health diagnosis

- Over 213,000 (30.9%) had a diagnosed behavioral health condition
- 37.1% of high schoolers.



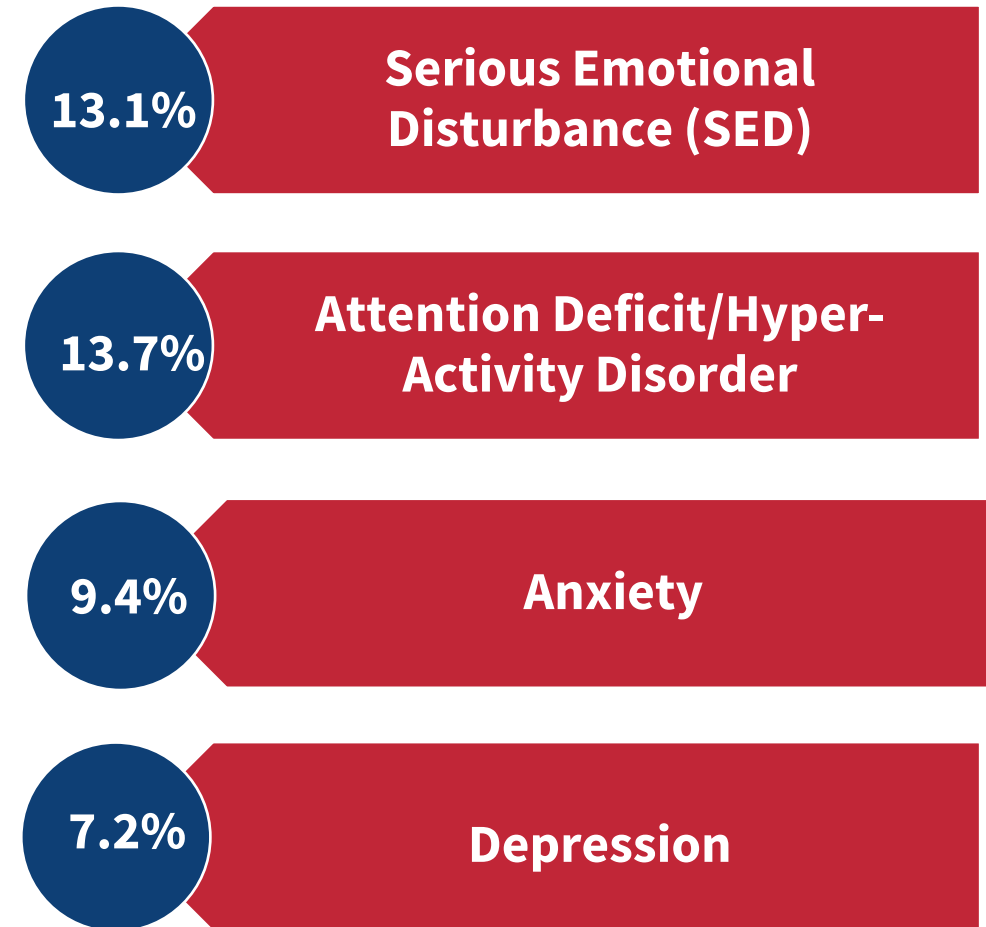
# Behavioral Health Diagnosis

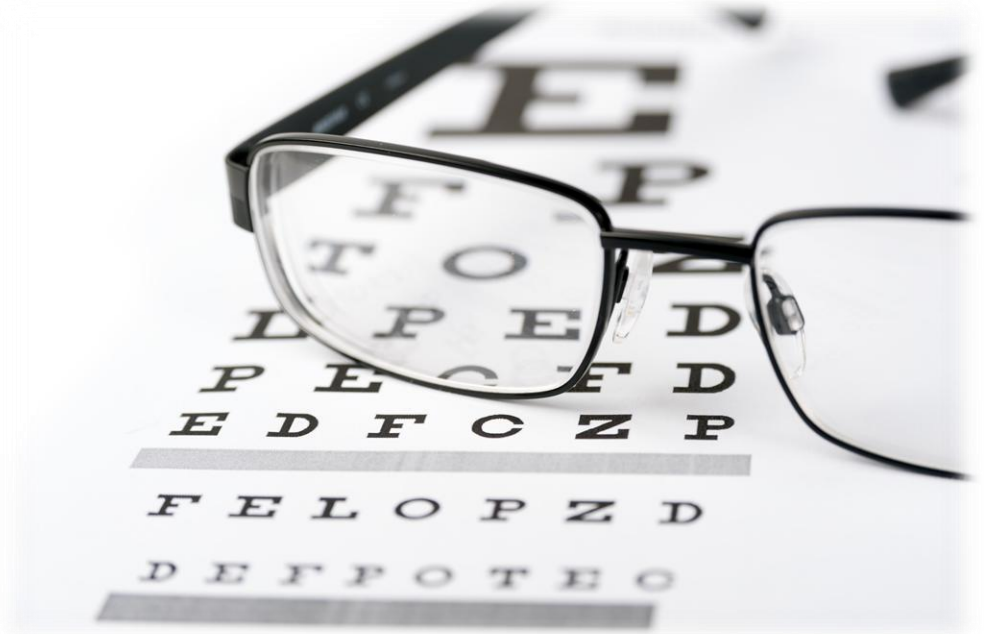
