## **Prior Year and Two Years Prior CTE Graduate Cohort**

- First time ninth graders in FY20XX
- Fiscal Year that student began Ninth Grade Element=20XX
- Met **CTE Concentrator Status** by Fourth year in High School

# ***UNDERSTANDING CTE PERKINS V CONCENTRATORS***

- CTE Perkins V Concentrators are secondary students
- They complete two Workforce Development courses
- Identification is based on course completion
- Concentrators can exist before program completion
- Courses may span different LEAs and years
- Early concentration is possible before 9th grade

## **Transfers In**

**Enrolled in District during High School**

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## **Graduates**

**Withdrawal Reason = "99"**

- Student reported with a diploma data, completed course requirements, and passed the appropriate statewide assessments required for high school graduation. In the case of a student on an IEP who has been excused from the individual consequences of the statewide assessments, using this code indicates that the student completed course requirements and took the appropriate statewide assessments required for high school graduation

# ***INCLUDED IN DENOMINATOR, CONT.***

## **High School Dropouts**

**WITHDRAWAL REASON = '71', '72', '73', '74', '75', '76', '77', '78', '79**

- Withdrawn due to Truancy, Pursued employment, over 18 years of Age, Moved not known to be continuing, completed course requirements but did not pass appropriate testing to meet graduation requirements, nonattendance according to 72-hour rule for community schools, withdrawn due to ORC 3314.26 or 3314.261 and No longer eligible to be enrolled in District

## **Reinstated Transfer**

**WITHDRAWAL REASON = '41' however, no admission in an Ohio school**

- Students who were withdrawn stating they were going to another Ohio school , but no public school reported enrollment

# REMOVED FROM DENOMINATOR

## Students Reported in Error

- WITHDRAWAL REASON = '81'

Transfer Out- another school district outside of Ohio, another Ohio district, a private school, a homeschool, by court order or adjudication or transferred out of the United States

- WITHDRAWAL REASON = '40', '41', '42', '43', '45', '46'

## Students who are deceased

- WITHDRAWAL REASON = '52'

# ***HOW ARE CERTAIN GRADUATES COUNTED?***

## ***EARLY GRADUATES***

- Early graduates count with their Graduation Cohort (i.e., if a student began 9<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2020 and graduated in the spring of 2024, they would count in the 2025 Graduation Cohort)

## ***“SUPER SENIORS”***

- Grade 13 or 23 students count with their Graduation Cohort and are considered Non-Graduates







# POTENTIAL IMPACT ON TRADITIONAL GRADUATION RATING

Example: At Evergreen High School, the graduates were not reported with a diploma date as expected. This school is one of two HS in the District, so one high school is reported with graduates, but the second high school is not.

# POTENTIAL IMPACT ON CTPD GRADUATION RATING

Example: Evergreen Local is part of a Compact CTPD with one other district. At Evergreen High School the graduates were not reported with a diploma date as expected. This meant that 16 Concentrators from Evergreen Local were not reported as graduates.




