The components are Achievement, Progress, Gap Closing, Early Literacy, Graduation, and College, Career, Workforce and Military Readiness (CCWMR). Districts and schools earn a star rating on the components and an overall star rating. This helps give Ohio parents and schools a snapshot of the quality of education they are providing to students. A weighted graduation rate is calculated using the weights established in Ohio Revised code 3302.03 so that the four-year graduation rate contributes 60% toward the component rating, and the five-year graduation rate contributes 40% toward the component rating.

Introduction

The Graduation Component is a measure of the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate and the five-year adjusted cohort graduation rate. A weighted graduation rate is calculated using the weights established in state law so that the four-year graduation rate contributes 60% toward the component rating, and the five-year graduation rate contributes 40% toward the component rating.

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

TEST YOUR KNOWLEDGE: GRADUATION COMPONENT

For the 2022-2023 Report Card, the 4-year graduation rate applies to students who are in the class of:

2022 or 2023





CALCULATION

After both the four- year and five-year adjusted cohort graduation rates are calculated, they are weighted to create a weighted overall graduation rate that is used to assign a rating to the Graduation Component.



Graduation

The Graduation Component is a measure of the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate and the five-year adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Weighted Graduation Rate

The weighted graduation rate combines the four- and five-year graduation rates into a single rate that is used to assign the Graduation Component rating. The four-year graduation rate is weighted at 60% and the five-year graduation rate is weighted at 40%.

4-Year Graduation Rate

The four-year graduation rate applies to students in the class of 2022 who graduated within four years. These are the students who entered ninth grade in the fall of 2018 and graduated by the summer of 2022.

5-Year Graduation Rate

The five-year graduation rate applies to students in the class of 2021 who graduated within five years. These are the students who entered ninth grade in the fall of 2017 and graduated by the summer of 2022.

GRADUATION COMPONENT CALCULATION

- 5-year Graduation contributes 40% to the Graduation Component
- 4-year Graduation contributes 60% of the Graduation Component

Greater than or equal to 96.5%	5 Stars	Significantly exceeds state standards in graduation rates			
Greater than or equal to 93.5% but less than 96.5%	4 Stars	Exceeds state standards in graduation rates			
Greater than or equal to 90% but less than 93.5%	3 Stars	Meets state standards in graduation rates			
Greater than or equal to 84% but less than 90%	2 Stars	Needs support to meet state standards in graduation rates			
Less than 84%	1 Star	Needs significant support to meet state standards in graduation rates			





EXAMPLE

Step One 4-year Grad Rate = 95.3%

Total = 93.02%

5-year Grad Rate = 89.6%




School Year Graduate Count (State) - Disaggregate Detail








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









5-Year Longitudinal Graduation Rate (School) - SSID Detail
