Graduation Component

Overview

The Graduation Component is a measure of the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate and the five-year adjusted cohort graduation rate. A weighted graduation rate is calculated using the weights established in [Ohio Revised code 3302.03](#) so that the four-year graduation rate contributes 60% toward the component rating, and the five-year graduation rate contributes 40% toward the component rating.

Introduction

CALCULATION

After both the four- year and five-year adjusted cohort graduation rates are calculated, they are weighted to create a weighted overall graduation rate that is used to assign a rating to the Graduation Component.

Graduation

The Graduation Component is a measure of the four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate and the five-year adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Weighted Graduation Rate

The weighted graduation rate combines the four- and five-year graduation rates into a single rate that is used to assign the Graduation Component rating. The four-year graduation rate is weighted at 60% and the five-year graduation rate is weighted at 40%.

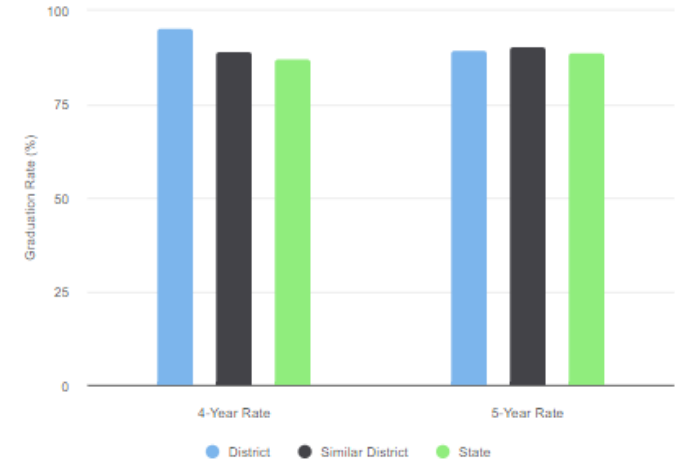

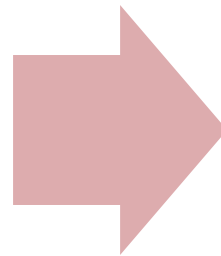

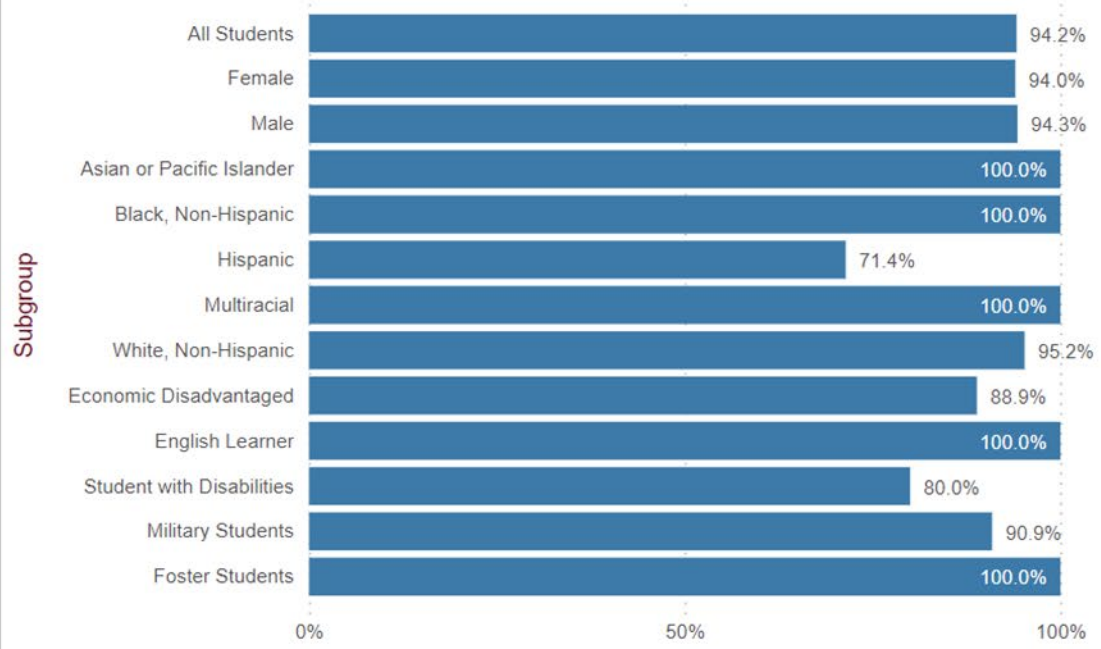

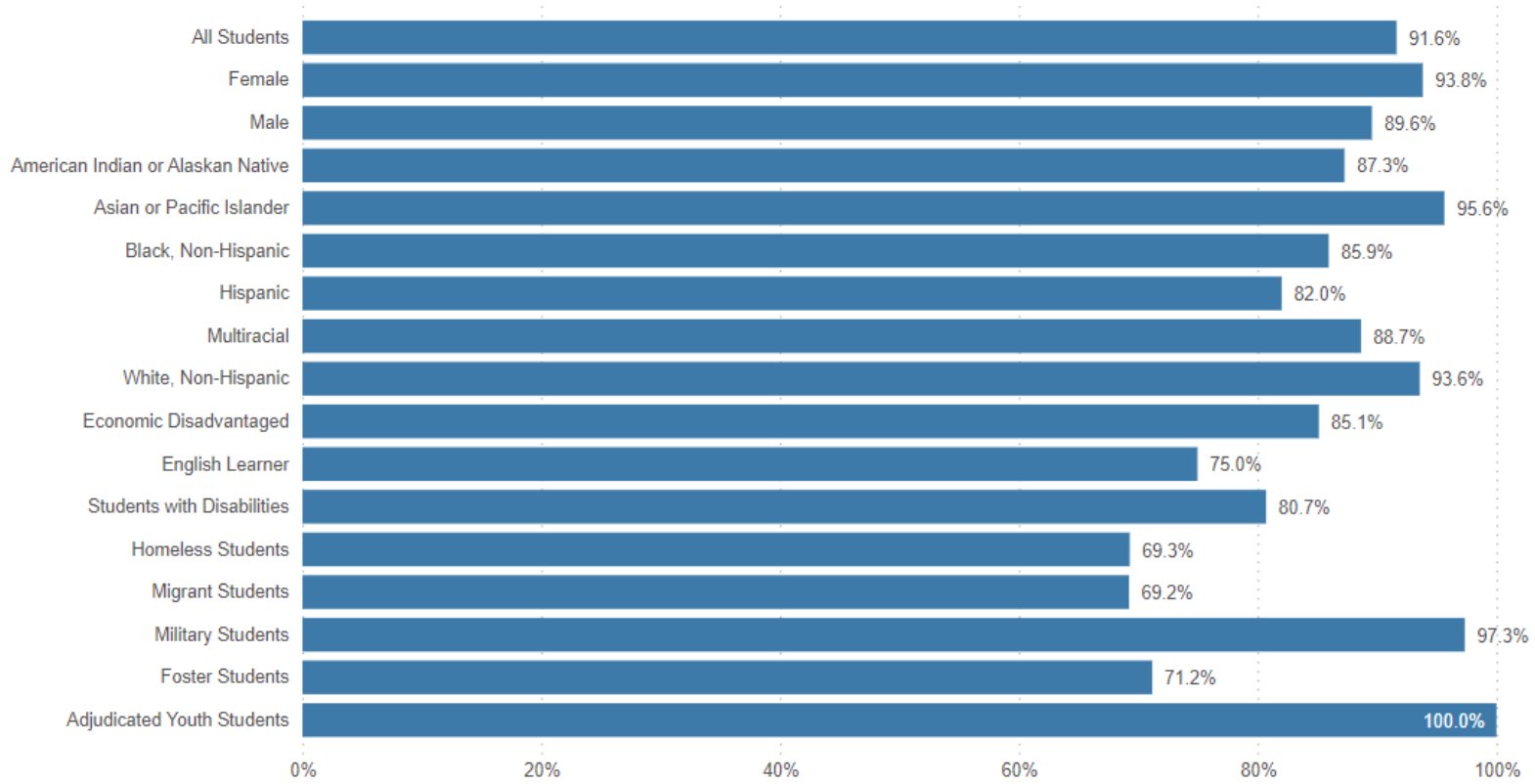

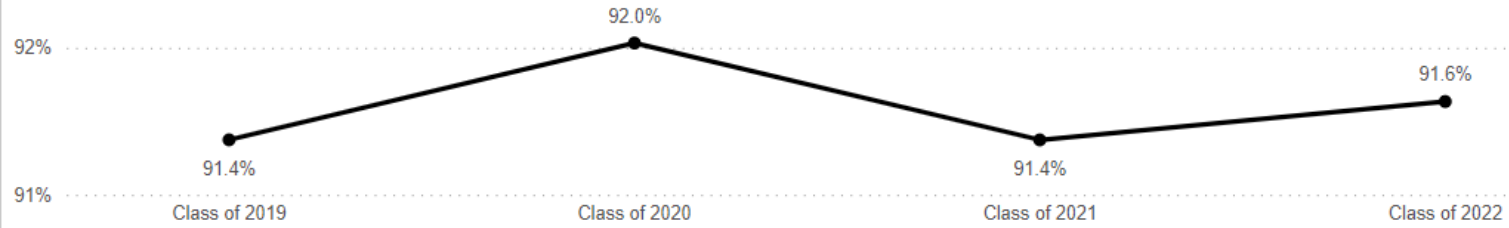

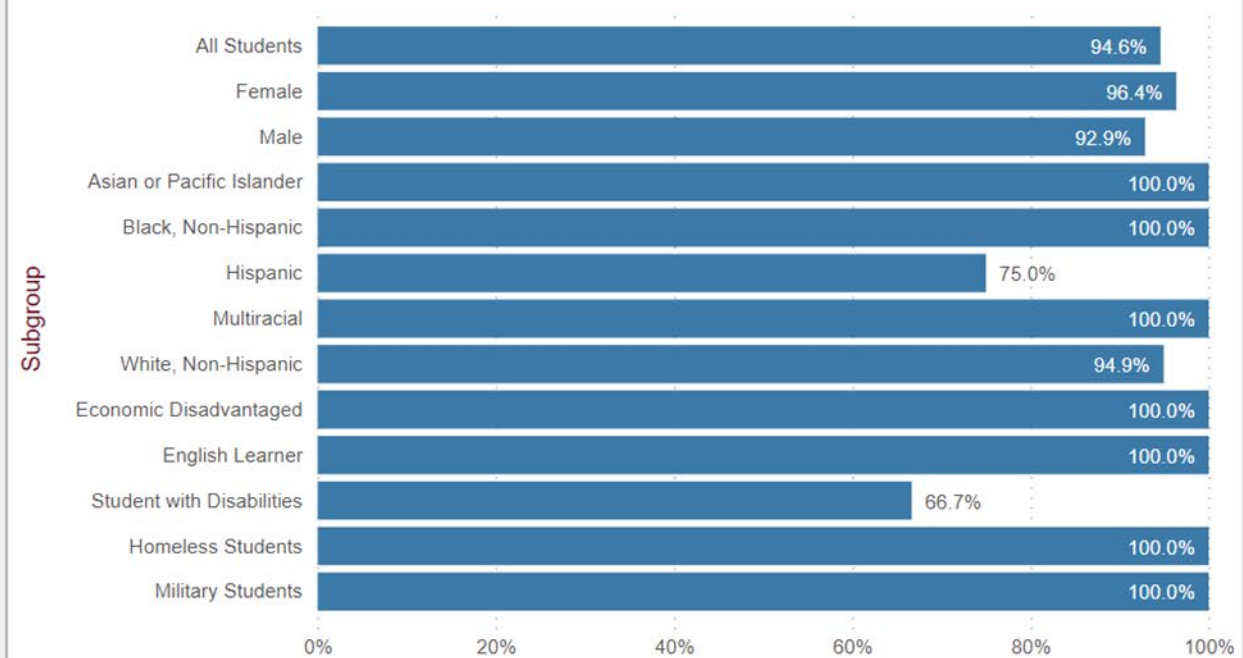

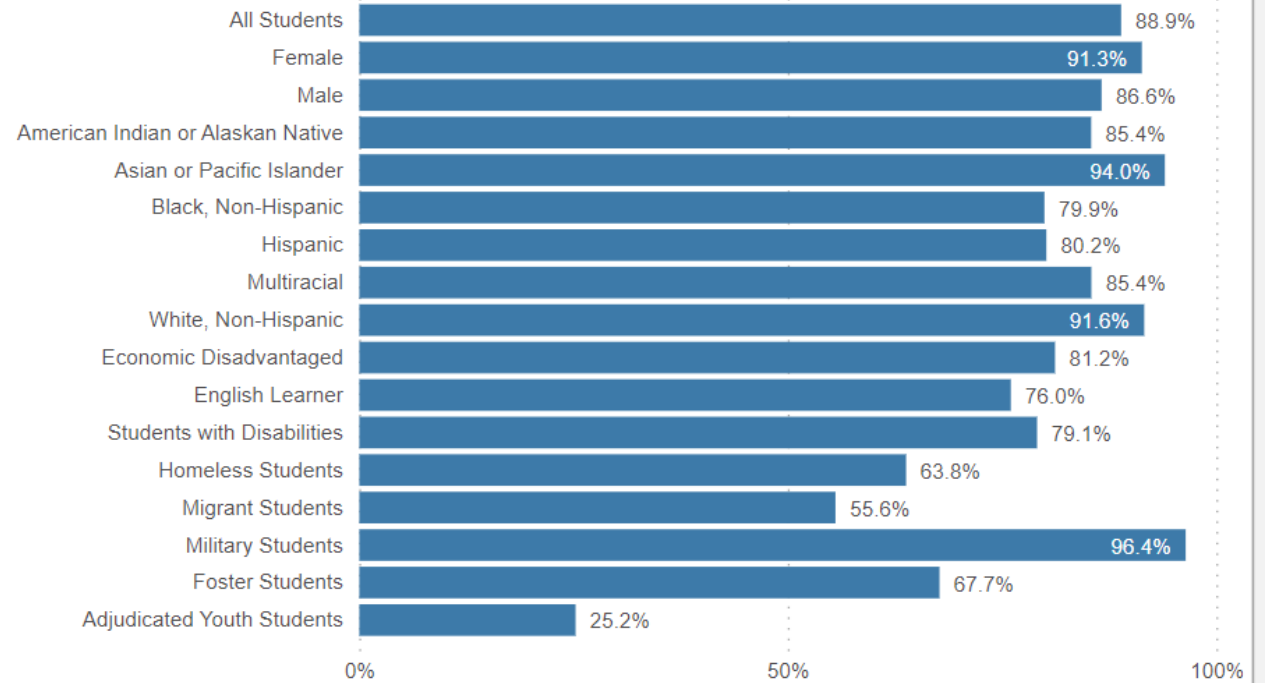

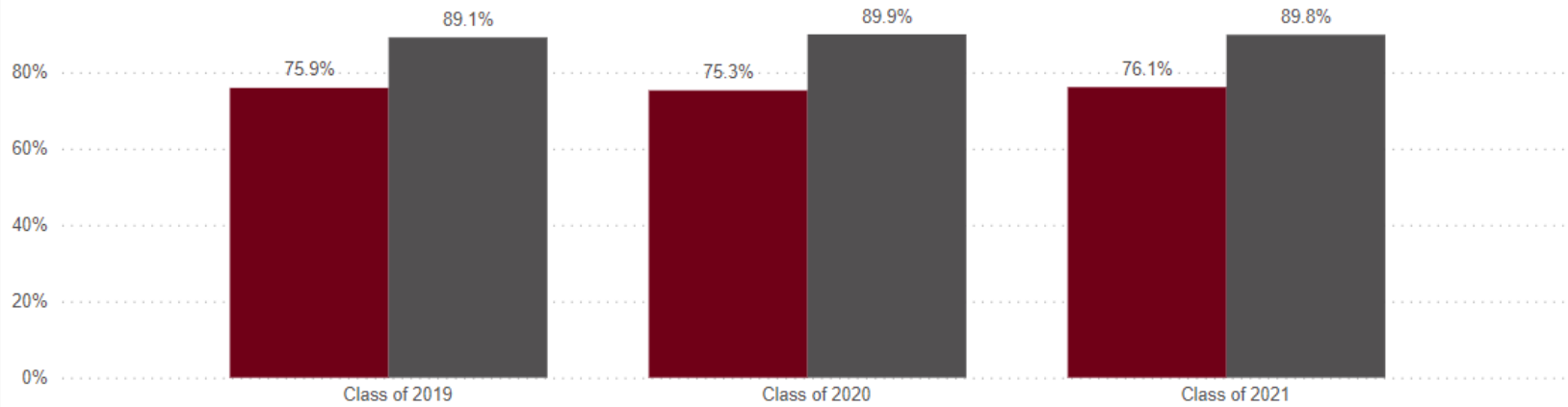

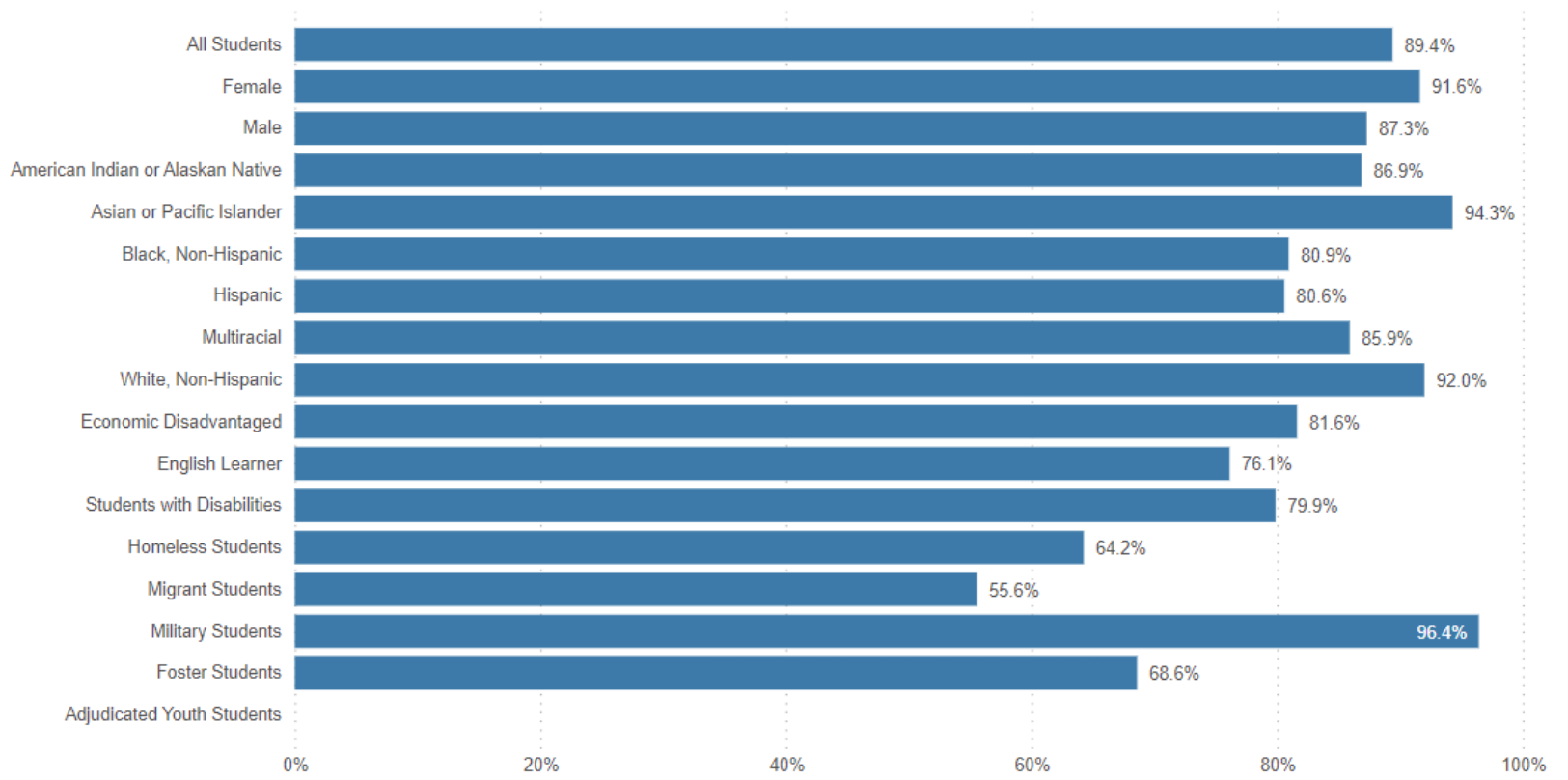
