

Beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, schools and districts reported the number of Fine Arts courses offered to their students. This measure is used to determine the breadth of Fine Arts courses available to students across districts and schools.

At the district level, if at least one student is reported with one of the Fine Arts Subject Codes listed below in any building within the district then the district is reported as having Fine Arts Courses. At the building level, if at least one student is reported with one of the Fine Arts Subject Codes listed below within the building then the building is reported as having Fine Arts Courses. The Fine Arts measure will be reported for all public and STEM districts and for all community and public schools.
