

## 2015-2016 Attendance Rate Calculation

<b>2015-2016 Attendance Rate Calculation</b>	
Definition:	<p>“Student Attendance Rate” means the ratio of the number of enrolled students actually in attendance (Aggregate Attendance) for a Full Academic Year to the number of enrolled students (Aggregate Membership) for that school year. <b>(OAC 3301-18-01)</b>. This number is expressed as a percentage.</p> <p><b>Student attendance is not included in the AMO calculation beginning with the 2013-14 school year and beyond, but it is calculated and displayed for each of the 10 student groups on the report card and on the AMO download file.</b></p>
Calculation:	$\text{Student Attendance Rate} = \frac{\text{Sum of total attendance hours for students enrolled in the district for a full academic year}}{\text{Sum total of student attendance + excused absence hours + unexcused absence hours for students enrolled in the district for a full academic year}} \times 100$

## 2015-2016 Attendance Rate Calculation

<b>Attendance Rate – Aggregate Membership</b>	
Definition:	<p>This is the denominator for the attendance rate. Aggregate Membership is the sum of the total attendance hours (hours that students were actually in attendance), excused absence hours and unexcused absence hours for all students the meet the criteria listed in the “Filter(s)” section of this calculation, who were in enrolled in the district or school for a “full academic year”.</p> <p>The aggregate membership (denominator) is calculated and reported for the “All Students” group as well as for each student subgroup that has at least 30 students. All calculations are performed using the data elements defined below.</p>
Calculation:	$\text{Aggregate Membership} = \frac{\text{Aggregate Attendance} + \text{Excused Absence Hours}}{\text{Absence Hours} + \text{Unexcused Absence Hours}}$
