

This document provides an overview of where to find Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) and Kindergarten Readiness Assessment Revised (KRA-R) aggregated results reported to the Education Management Information System (EMIS). If you need assistance finding KRA or KRA-R data, please contact KRAhelp@childrenandyouth.ohio.gov.

The information can be found in the following locations:

Download Data - Summary tables for all years of Kindergarten Readiness and Kindergarten Readiness Revised. There are 5 files available for each year starting with the 2014-2015 school year.

- Building KRA has results by traditional Public-School building.
- Community School KRA has results calculated by Community School.
- *District Disaggregated KRA* has results by district and student groups (Disability, Economic Disadvantaged, English Learner, Gender, Race/Ethnicity, and Gender).
- District KRA has results by Traditional Public School District and by County.
- State Overall KRA has results for state overall and broken out by student groups.

Note: In the Download Data section, all files are labeled with "KRA," though beginning in school year 2020-21 the results are for the shortened version, the "KRA-R."

Advanced Reports Portal – Most reports are interactive via dropdown lists, radio buttons or check boxes. The Kindergarten Readiness Assessment Revised is available in the Report Portal starting with school year 2020-2021. Data is displayed mostly in graphs and tables. For each tab, select the School Year(s), District(s), and Subgroup(s) when applicable. Results are available by District, Community School, State, and County.

Secure Data Center (SDC) – available only to district and school users who have access. After the data has been submitted to EMIS, this can be found under OHID in the Report Portal app under 'Secure Data Center', then 'Test Results'.

Download Data:

1. **Go to https://reportcard.education.ohio.gov/** and **select the 3 lines** in the upper right corner, then select **Download Data** from the drop-down box.





2. **Select The School Year(s), Categories, and or data file.** The 'select a data file to download' field will populate with the files available based on selections made in the school year and categories options.

- 3. After selecting the file to view, it should appear in your browser's downloads as an Excel file. Click on the file and it will open to the Data Notes tab. The data will be available on the other tab(s).
- 4. The download files for 2023-2024 have both years in the name until the 2023-2024 option is available (in the fall when report card data is released). Example:
