

May use the days following the TPC to confirm residency and gather other documentation

The Preschool Transition from Part C to Part B Optional Form may be used to document the district's participation at the TPC and to track important dates.





TRANSITION PLANNING CONFERENCE TIMELINE



Early Intervention conducts initial evaluation & holds Individual Family Service Plan meeting



Transition notification sent to district = invitation to TPC



Determining Preschool Special Education is shared between Part C and Part B





Individualized Education
Program MUST be developed and implemented on or before third birthday


Knowledge Check

LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY REPORTING RESPONSIBILITIES

- District of Residence reports events to EMIS
- Preschool Transition Conference triggers Indicator 12 calculation
- Contact EMIS Coordinator for reporting questions



PART C REFERRAL DATE

Part C referral date will be the earliest of the following:

If TPC or first notification more than 150 days before 3rd birthday

Part C Referral Date is 150 days before third birthday

If first notification from Part C is within 150 days before third birthday

Part C Referral Date is date of first notification from Part C

If TPC is within 150 days before third birthday

Part C Referral Date is date of the TPC



LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCY REPORTING RESPONSIBILITIES

Initial Evaluation Team Report confirms disability

Initial Individualized Education Program developed and implemented on or before third birthday

Implemented means that the Individualized Education Program has been signed **AND** all identified services begin on or before the child's third birthday!



All dates reported should depict what is truly taking place and when it is taking place.



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
