PROGRAM OVERVIEW

95 Phonics Booster Bundle: Summer School is a 25-day program to support rising first-, second-, and third-grade students with daily lessons lasting 30 to 45 minutes. Depending on student needs, teachers can use the lessons sequentially or modularly to close gaps before the next school year begins. Kits include sound-spelling cards, student manipulatives, workbooks, and lessons.

The program is a tier 2 solution focused on phonics instruction for rising 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade students. It is a 25-day program designed to address urgent skill gaps by providing explicit phonics instruction to quickly address learning loss. Teachers are provided scripted phonics and word study lessons to intensively help students who have experienced gaps during the prior school year to catch up.

Educators use this structured literacy program during the summer or at the beginning of the school year to cover critical skills right away - even before all beginning of year (BOY) assessments are completed. The lessons require minimal teacher prep and can be used for whole-class or small group instruction.

PROGRAM ALIGNMENT WITH THE SCIENCE OF READING AND STRATEGIES FOR EFFECTIVE LITERACY INSTRUCTION

95 Phonics Booster Bundle: Summer School is grounded in research and evidence, aligning with the science of reading. It builds on the foundation of the 95 Phonics Lesson Library and 95 Phonics Chip Kits, developed by the 95 Percent Group. The program's design is based on studies from the National Reading Panel report and further supported by research in David Kilpatrick's 2015 book, *Essentials of Assessing, Preventing, and Overcoming Reading Difficulties*.

Key principles include:

- * Systematic phonics instruction is more effective than unplanned skill instruction.
- * Effective phonics instruction follows a sequence from simple to complex, with lessons building on mastered concepts.

- * Explicit instruction yields the best results, using direct teaching of phonics concepts and emphasizing patterns through manipulatives, gestures, and reading-writing connections.
- * Orthographic mapping is crucial for word recognition, supported by activities like using sound chips in Elkonin boxes and phoneme-grapheme mapping.
