## **Dear Superintendent:**

Thank you for submitting the Foundation Academy Reading Achievement Plan Progress Report. Upon review, the Department of Education and Workforce sees progress and appreciates your time and commitment in implementing the comprehensive literacy plan.

Below, the Department's literacy team has provided feedback and resources in response to the information provided in the Reading Achievement Plan Progress Report:

• We appreciate your community school's introspective response about the progress made on your Reading Achievement Plan. Specifically, the school notes the importance of ongoing support for the 120-minute ELA/Writing block, including training, resources, and coaching for teachers. However a balanced literacy framework including the use of instructional strategies such as guided reading, and reading and writing workshop are not evidence-based literacy practices grounded in the science of reading. Core instruction and intervention practices should be explicit, systematic, and structured. A balanced literacy framework does not align to the principles of an evidence-based structured literacy approach.
