Assessment Overview

Overview for districts describing in detail the assessment, its use and how the vendor supports implementation of the assessment.

Acadience Reading K–6 is a universal screening assessment that measures the acquisition of early literacy and reading skills from kindergarten through sixth grade. Acadience Reading K–6 consists of brief measures that function as indicators of the essential skills that every child must master to become a proficient reader. These measures are used to regularly monitor student progress in the development of early literacy skills in order to provide timely instructional support and prevent the occurrence of later reading difficulties. Benchmarks are available for all measures and grades. Benchmarks define a level at which students are likely to meet later reading outcomes. Additionally, Acadience Reading includes measures that serve as risk indicators to better assist educators to identify students who may be most at-risk for reading difficulties.

Acadience Learning supports schools and districts to implement Acadience Reading K-6 by providing high-quality professional development, ongoing implementation support and data management services for those who use Acadience Reading assessment.

Acadience Learning offers user two methods of administration - 1) digital administration via Acadience Learning Online (ALO), a web-based application or 2) manual administration via paper-pencil.

Assessment materials may be downloaded for free or purchased in classroom kits. Acadience Reading materials are also available in Braille. Information on assessment materials, including access to the free download hub, can be found at <https://acadiencelarning.org/acadience-reading/k-grade6>.

Data Management services are available via Acadience Learning Online (ALO) to educators who administer digitally as well as paper-pencil. ALO application supports digital administration with automatic syncing of data or manual entry of scores obtained via paper-pencil administration. Regardless of administration method, ALO provides dynamic and flexible data views and reporting capabilities. ALO provides data visualizations at the district, school, grade level, classroom, and student level. ALO supports educators with instructional grouping capabilities and offers parent communication options. ALO supports SSO capabilities as well as multiple rostering methods.
