## Assessment Overview

### Assessment Detail

**ReadBasix is an up-to-date, science-of-reading-based diagnostic reading assessment for Grades 3-12 that can be used to inform instruction and intervention.** ReadBasix measures five foundational reading skills—word recognition and decoding, vocabulary, morphology, sentence processing, and reading efficiency—and basic reading comprehension. The skills measured by ReadBasix are divided into six subtests; therefore, ReadBasix subtests can be given all at once or individually.

### Assessment Uses

**ReadBasix may be used as a screener to identify students who may need additional reading support, as a diagnostic tool to identify the specific readings skills in which students require additional support, as a seasonal benchmark, and as a progress monitoring tool to measure whether or not an intervention is effective based on students' improvement.** Progress monitoring may be completed for individual skills or as a complete battery.

### Implementation Support

**The Capti literacy team provides the main servicing for district or school implementation, including data analysis and PD.** Capti's literacy team is comprised of former teachers and literacy leaders.
