What is mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition?

The Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS) assessment is a set of brief, standardized, individually administered measures of early literacy designed to predict the literacy growth of children from Kindergarten through eighth grade. The six DIBELS measures reflect the essential early literacy domains described in the National Reading Panel and National Research Council reports. The measures address the key domains: phonological awareness, graphophonemic knowledge, word reading, oral reading accuracy, and comprehension of text.

How is DIBELS Administered?

mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition represents a unique approach to literacy assessment in the early grades.

Each assessor administers the assessment in real time on a mobile device to an individual student. As the student responds to print stimulus materials, the test administrator records student responses. This system leverages the efficiency of technology without compromising the quality of the student-teacher interaction. It ensures that the collected data is more valid and reliable than alternative approaches and as a result leads to accurate inferences about student ability. During the assessment, the software analyzes data in real-time. When the assessment is complete, the teacher receives immediate reporting and recommended instructional resources on their mobile device.

How is mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition used?

mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition provides benchmark assessment materials for conducting universal screening three times per year, at the beginning, middle, and end of the school year. mCLASS DIBELS 8th Edition also includes progress monitoring forms for testing at-risk students more frequently to ensure they are making progress. The purpose of DIBELS 8th Edition is as a formative assessment used to make instructional decisions. When delivered on the mCLASS platform, the assessment includes a rich array of reporting and links to instructional resources.
