INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE AFFIDAVIT OF INTENT NOT TO DISCRIMINATE & RACIAL NONDISCRIMINATORY POLICIES

To be eligible for technical assistance from the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce (DEW), the governing board of a nonpublic school must:

- 1. Submit an original Affidavit of Intent Not to Discriminate which must be signed and notarized; and
- 2. Adopt and implement racial nondiscriminatory policies. Copies of such policies must be submitted for approval to DEW on official school letterhead. (Refer to the Racial Nondiscriminatory Policies document online for required language.)
