## INSTRUCTIONS FOR AFFIDAVIT OF INTENT NOT TO DISCRIMINATE & THE RACIAL NONDISCRIMINATION POLICIES

To be eligible for technical assistance from the Ohio Department of Education & Workforce, the governing board of a nonpublic school must:

- 1. submit an original Affidavit of Intent Not to Discriminate which must be signed and notarized; and
- 2. adopt and implement racial nondiscriminatory policies. Copies of such policies shall be submitted for approval to the department on official school letterhead. (Refer to the Racial Nondiscrimination Policies document online for required language.)
