

2026 Purple Star Rubric

Renewal Application

The Purple Star Award recognizes schools that show a major commitment to students and families connected to our nation's military. A school is honored with the Purple Star Award if they complete all the *required* activities. Renewing schools are required to show evidence of directly engaging and supporting military-connected students. This rubric can assist schools as they prepare to submit their application for the Purple Star Award.

The Department will review and score evidence using the following scoring characteristics:

- **Needs Remediation** - The evidence provided does not meet the criteria indicated.
- **Meets Requirements** - The evidence provided fully meets the criteria indicated.
- **Exceeds Requirements** - The evidence provided exceeds the criteria indicated.

To earn the award, a school must receive a rating of at least **Meets Requirements** for each category. Any criteria listed as **Needs Remediation** requires the school to submit additional evidence to be considered. Schools may provide new evidence during the remediation period from January 15 to March 1. New evidence should be emailed to purplestar@education.ohio.gov prior to midnight on March 1.
