

Autism Scholarship Education Plan Checklist

Plans for students should include educational services of tuition at a participating chartered nonpublic school. Additionally, schools districts may choose to include related support services and therapies in autism education plans.

Educational services:

- Tuition to enroll in a chartered nonpublic school that is approved to participate in the Autism Scholarship Program

Related services and therapies:

- Services provided by a public school district or an approved Autism Scholarship Program business provider*
 - Behavior Services
 - Counseling Services
 - Interpreter Services
 - Medical Services
 - Occupational Therapy Services
 - Orientation & Mobility Services
 - Physical Therapy Services
 - Psychology Services
 - Recreational Services
 - Rehabilitation Counseling Services
 - School Health Services
 - School Nurse Services
 - School Psychologist Services
 - Social Work Services
 - Special Transportation Services
 - Speech and Language Services (In-Person)
 - Transitional Services
 - Adapted Physical Education Services
 - Aide Services
 - Attendant Services
 - Audiologist Services

Other Services:

- Intervention services provided by a chartered nonpublic school that is approved to participate in the Autism Scholarship Program

*Home educated students participating in the Autism Scholarship Program must use funds for services provided by an approved Autism Scholarship Program business provider.
