[State law](#) allows traditional public school districts to elect to combine the data of certain new startup community schools with that of their district schools for the purpose of calculating the performance of the district as a whole on the Local Report Card.

- In order to make use of the provision, the startup community school must be located in the district and the district must either: 1) lease a building to the community school; or 2) enter into an agreement with the community school in which the district and community school endorse each other's programs. If the district is the sponsor of the new startup community school, the verification form alone is sufficient, because the school's contract is already on file with the department.

To use this provision for the 2014-2015 school year, the district must submit this form with any additional required materials to the Office of Community Schools on or before **Thursday, October 30, 2014**. If your district does not sponsor the new startup community school, you must provide a copy of the lease or agreement that is in effect between the district and the new startup community school during the 2014-2015 school year. The district's decision to include the community school's performance data with its own data becomes binding for the 2014-2015 school year upon receipt of an acceptable form and any additional required materials by the Office of Community Schools. Please note that this process must be finalized in time for you to review your district's EMIS HQT reports before the close of October FY15 EMIS. No late submissions can be accepted. Additionally, it is the responsibility of the district to ensure that data from the community school are rolling up to the district appropriately.
