# **English Learner Identification Checklist and Supplemental Questions**

This checklist is meant to support English learner services and is not a required part of a student's school record.

1.	<b>Check.</b> Confirm that the Language Usage Survey was administered properly.
	☐ The school informed the student's parent(s) or guardian(s) of the purposes of the Language Usage Survey.
	☐ The school presented the survey to parent(s) or guardian(s) in a language and form that was accessible.
	☐ (For transfer students) The school requested any previous language survey data and English learner records.
2.	<b>Screen.</b> Students whose home or primary language is not English are administered the Ohio English Language Proficiency Screener.
	☐ Yes, assess the student's English proficiency.
	□ No, do not assess the student's English proficiency.
3.	<b>Notify.</b> If a school identifies a student as an English learner, the parent or guardian must receive notification of services within 30 days of enrollment. If the student enrolls midyear, the parent or guardian must receive notification within two weeks of placement into an English language development program.

## **Supplemental Questions**

Staff can use the list of questions below as a reference in conversation with families to better understand a student's language background and prior education.

### LANGUAGE AND LITERACY BACKGROUND

- What is your child's first or primary language?
- Does your child understand and speak a language other than English?
- Does your child read and write in a language other than English?
- Does your child "mix" languages? Describe.
- What language do you use most frequently with your child?
- What other language(s) do you use with your child?
- What other language(s) does your child understand or use?

#### PRIOR EDUCATION

- Has your child ever been identified by a school as an English learner?
- Where has your child attended schools in the U.S. or other countries?
- Do you have previous school records?
- How long has your child been in U.S. schools?
- In what languages has your child previously received instruction?
- Did your child attend school before kindergarten?
- Does your student have an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or 504 plan?

### INTERRUPTED FORMAL EDUCATION AND ATTENDANCE

- Was there a period of time when your child did not consistently attend school?
- Before coming to the U.S., was your child separated from other family members?
