Public Notification	Public media notice required regarding program and eligibility. The Office of Nutrition issues an annual media release on behalf of SFSP sponsors.	No public notification required, but sponsor must advertise sites to community
Training	<ul> <li>School district required to train program staff annually</li> <li>Annual online SFSP training required.</li> </ul>	School district encouraged to conduct NSLP/SBP training of local staff, but not required
Rural Non Congregate Option	Eligible Deadline to submit Rural Non Congregate Application Addendum is 10 days prior to first operating day or June 15, whichever is earlier.
