

Eligibility Determination Form for Students Experiencing Housing Instability

This form is designed to help a district homeless liaison determine whether a student is homeless as defined by the federal McKinney-Vento Act. Answers may be used to help determine if the student meets eligibility requirements for services. The district liaison may use this as an interview form and give a copy of it to the family after completing the form. Liaisons may want to keep this form as an ongoing tool to keep notes on throughout the duration of a student's homelessness.
