Section 3319.52(B) of the Ohio Revised Code requires:

If there is any judicial finding of guilt or any conviction or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction against a license holder, or if a license holder agrees to participate in a pre-trial diversion program, for any of the offenses listed in division (B)(2) or (C) of section 3319.31 of the Revised Code, the prosecutor in the case, on forms that the state board of education shall prescribe and furnish, promptly shall notify the board and, if known, any school district or chartered nonpublic school employing the license holder of the license holder's name and residence address, and the fact that the license holder pleaded guilty to, was convicted of, has been found eligible for intervention in lieu of conviction for, or has agreed to a diversion program for the offense.

THE REPORT SHOULD BE ACCOMPANIED BY CERTIFIED COPIES OF THE CHARGING AFFIDAVIT OR COMPLAINT, THE PLEA, AND THE ORDER OF CONVICTION AND SENTENCING. The report and the accompanying papers should be mailed to:
